Night Session Set for House

Split on but one item on the special session agenda, the Succession Duties Tax Act, the Ontario Legislature will sit tonight on second reading and possible committee stages of the bill, Premier Hepburn announced yesterday.

The announcement was made at the close of yesterday's sitting, when the Premier said he had just received word of the death of Mrs. Ross, wife of Judge Duncan Ross, who is the son of Hon. George Ross, former Premier. He said he would fly to Strathroy in the afternoon.

"I hope to get back in time for the night session," he said. "There will be a night session, at which the Succession Duties Act will be before the House."
