## *Ask Grading Rule Explanation*

Yesterday's meeting of the Legislature's agricultural committee was of short duration, owing to the fact that representatives of the Department of Agriculture who were to have explained the cheese bonus and the methods of its application were unable to attend.

Chairman H. C. Nixon, Temiskaming, stated that it was possible to have a representative of the Federal Department of Agriculture attend a future meeting in order to explain the new Federal egg-grading regulations.

"These regulations have caused

great dissatisfaction in my county," stated C. G. Mercer, Liberal, Durham, "particularly among the farmers who are selling in the smaller centres." Other members agreed with him that a representative of the Federal department be asked to attend and enlighten them on the new regulations.

D. M. Campbell, Kent East, announced that at next Thursday's meeting L. E. O'Neill and William Watson of the Provincial department would attend to discuss the hog bonus and various features of that subsidy.
