

CONANT NAMES PROBE GROUP

All-Liberal Committee on Bargaining Bill

Premier Conant announced over the week-end the personnel of the select committee on labor to inquire into collective bargaining. The committee will meet Thursday morning at Queen's Park to organize and make plans for the sittings.

Speaker James Clarke, Windsor, will be chairman of the committee, and associated with him will be the following Liberal members of the Legislature: E. J. Anderson, Welling; W. J. Gardhouse, York West; J. A. A. Habel, Cochrane North; H. L. Hagey, Brantford; John Newlands, Hamilton Centre; F. R. Oliver, Gray South; J. P. MacKay, Hamilton East; and T. P. Murray, Renfrew South.

Refusal of the Progressive Conservatives to name three members to the committee compelled the Government to make good the deficiency by appointing three additional Liberals, making it an all-Liberal body.
