hereby required to give an attested Copy of such Affidavit so made before Settlement, them to the Person making the same, in order that he may produce it they shall when required; which attested Copy shall at any Time be admitted as accordingly; Evidence as to such last legal Settlement before any of His Majesty's an attested Justices of the Peace at any General or Quarter Sessions of the Peace: Copy where-Provided always, that in case any such Officer, Mariner, Soldier, or given them. Marine shall again be summoned to make Oath as aforesaid, then on such attested Copy of the Oath by him formerly taken being produced by him or by any other Person on his Behalf, such Officer, Mariner, Soldier, or Marine shall not be obliged to take any other or further Oath with regard to his legal Settlement, but shall leave a Copy of such attested Copy of and if sumhis Examination, if required.

III. And be it further enacted, That this Act, and every Part thereof, shall extend to all Officers and Soldiers who have personally served in the Militia, or any of the Fencible Regiments, from the faid Sixteenth Day of July One thousand seven hundred anc eighty-four, for the Term of Five Years, and have been honourably discharged.

IV. Provided always, That this Act shall not in anywise be prejudicial to the Privileges of the Universities of Cambridge and Oxford, or either of them, or extend to give Liberty to any Person to set up the Trade of a Vintner, or to fell any Wine or other Liquors within the faid Univerfities without Licence first had and obtained from the Vice Chancellor of the same respectively.
