


The Lake Ontario & Bay of Quinte Steamboat Company passes illustrated above, for NORSEMAN in 1881, and for NORTH KING in 1899, come to us courtesy of Gordon Wendt, of Sandusky, and we extend to him our thanks. Note the two stacks in the likeness of NORTH KING, despite the fact that we believe that she carried only one stack from 1897 onward. We also should note that the Gildersleeve signature does appear on the original of the NORSEMAN pass, even though it did not reproduce in our copy.
