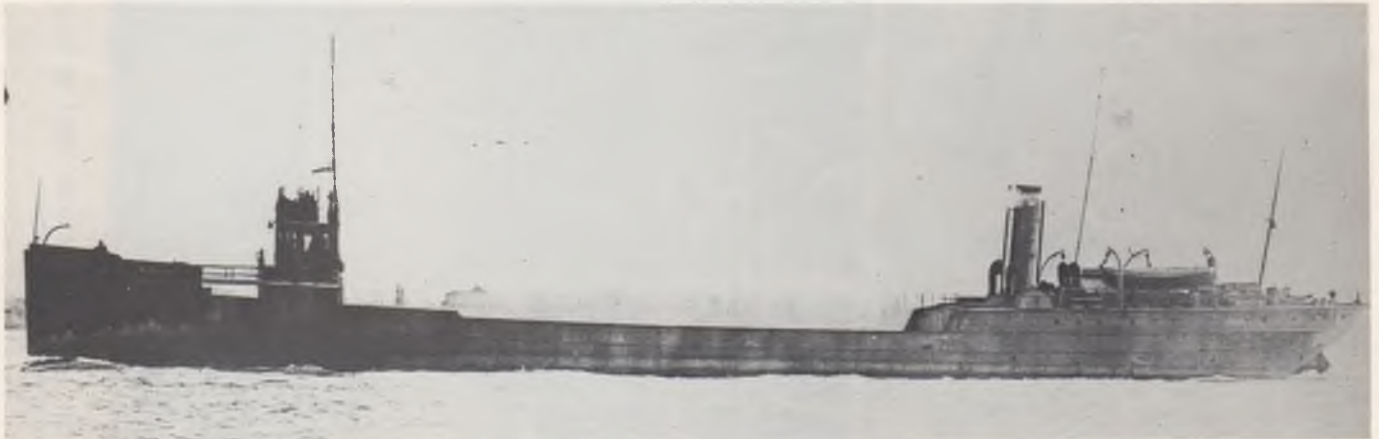


The almost new PIONEER is seen in the "new" dock of the Detroit Dry Dock Company, completed in 1892 at the foot of Orleans Street, Detroit.
