Halton Catholic board begins process of naming new Milton elementary school

The Halton Catholic District School Board will begin the process of choosing a name for its newest Milton elementary school.

Milton No. 8 Catholic elementary school, as it's known at this time, will be a two-storey building accommodating 671 students and located on Whitlock Avenue east of Bronte Street and south of Louis St. Laurent.

A school name selection committee will include trustees, a superintendent, school principal, pastor of the associated parish and parent representatives.

The mandate of the committee will be to develop a list of at least two school names to be approved by the board. Potential names will also be forwarded to Bishop Douglas Crosby for review. Public feedback will also be sought including from those parents and students who are members of the new school community.

An update to the board with potential names and community feedback will be part of the March 6 board meeting.

Attendance boundaries for the new school were also approved at the Jan. 16 meeting.

The new boundaries take into consideration concerns about rural students (fewer than 10) currently attending St. Benedict Catholic Elementary School by allowing them to remain at the school instead of moving to Milton No. 8, at least for the time being. This would avoid multiple moves for these students as they were initially transferred from Our Lady of Victory, according to a report presented at the meeting.

Existing Grade 7 students at St. Benedict will also be allowed to remain at the school but without transportation.
