welcome and encouraged speaks to his leadership and teamwork skills. He joins a group of outstanding principals and educators from the Halton District School Board who have received this award."


Each year, 40 principals across the country are recognized for demonstrating innovation, entrepreneurial spirit and for their remarkable efforts toward improving public education.

The Learning Partnership (www.thelearningpartnership.ca) invites nominations of outstanding principals from school/ boards, colleagues, parents, teachers, students and community members.




