MISFORTUNE COULD BE MERCY IN DISGUISE

Motivational speaker and author, Dennis Waitley, once found himself racing to catch a flight. He was on his way from Chicago to Los Angeles and had to board DC10 flight 191 to deliver a speech later in the day. But he didn't get to the gate on time - the gate agent was locking the door just as he arrived. He pleaded with her to open the gate and let him board the plane. She resolutely refused. Waitley was furious. He left the boarding area in disgust and made his way to the ticket counter to see what could be done about getting him to his destination asap.

As he stood in ticket line, the tragic news came through that the plane he had missed boarding had crashed on take-off, killing all passengers on board. Instantly, his anger and disappointment turned to shock, and later to gratitude.

Waitley left the ticket line and checked into a room at an airport hotel. Before going to sleep, he knelt in prayer beside his bed and thanked God for His mercy. The next day, he decided to keep his unused ticket rather than returning it for a refund. Rather, he put it on the wall of his home office. It acts a silent reminder to him. And every so often, when he gets annoyed at something, his wife Susan leads him into his office and urges him to look at his unused flight 191 ticket. Waitley says, "Every day is a gift to be lived to the full!"

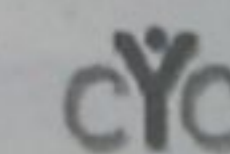
