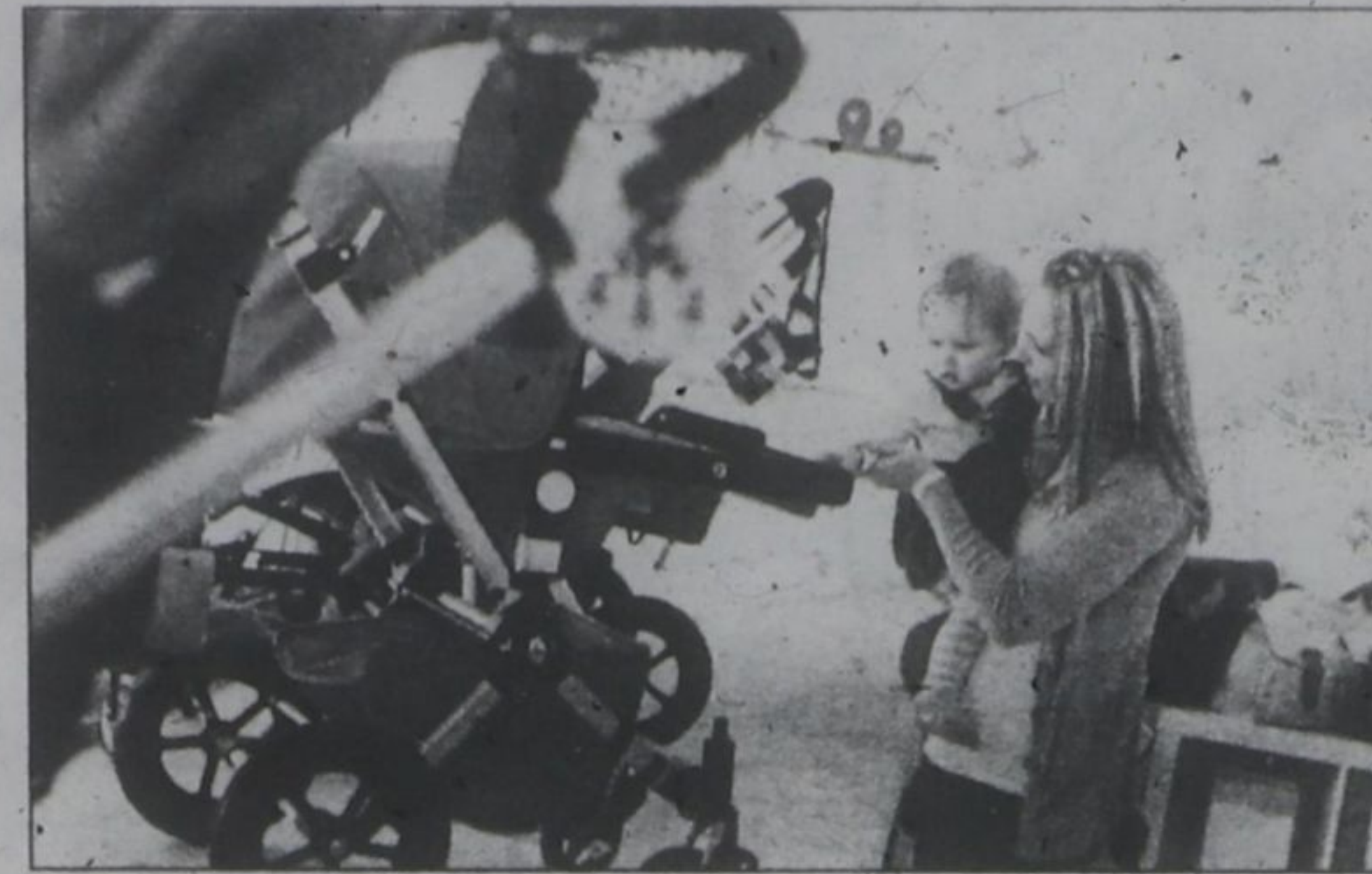

"Do the same with the third," he urged. The boy had to use all his strength to uproot it.

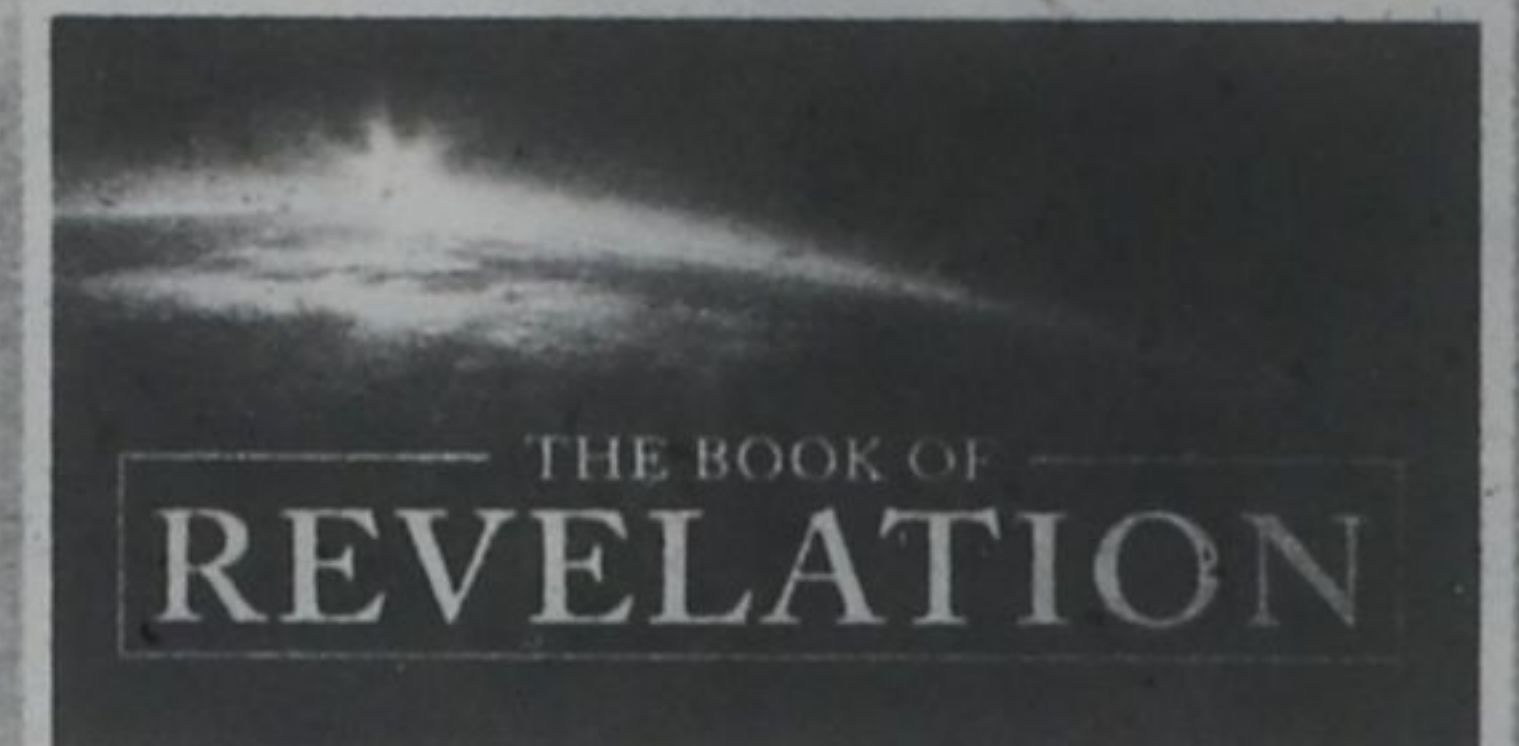
