With three wins and nine nominations, the Milton Players' achievements at this year's Act-co Awards April 7 were the loftiest in its history.

The awards recognize outstanding performances and achievements in local community theatre, with Thea Awards given to the winners.

Milton Players' second show of the season, Noises Off, earned eight nominations and three wins.

The three Theas went to Arleigh Curran for best supporting actress in a comedy, Sandra Curran for best stage manager and the change crew for winning an Adjudicator Award for best set change.

Those nominated for an award for Noises Off included Dennis Curley for best supporting actor, Kim
