## Vote Prosperity message to be pushed during campaign

Over the course of the campaign, local chambers and boards of trade will be boldly pushing the Vote Prosperity message through debates, events and stakeholder meetings.

"The Milton Chamber of Commerce and local chambers and boards of trade across the province have been advocating tirelessly with local candidates and elected officials, highlighting business priorities for this election," said Scott McCammon, President & CEO - Milton Chamber of Commerce. Vote Prosperity is based on four pillars for Ontario:

Detitiveness: Rising input costs, especially those costs deriving from government regulation and policy, are the most common and acute concern of the business community in Ontario.

. Foster Job Creation: A robust labour market consisting of good jobs is essential to prosperity for all Ontarians.

. Build Healthy Communities: Building strong communities through adequate and affordable housing, sustainable health care, and good infrastructure also supports business prosperity and growth, which supports those communities.

. Improve Government Accountability: Poor implementation of government initiatives can result in resource waste, political frustration and disruption for ordinary citizens, as


