penalty for that offence and a more severe penalty for the recruitment of persons who are under 18 years of age." In 2015, Gill told the Punjabi Post that he entered federal politics because legalized same-sex marriage had pushed him "over the edge." Two years later, when he won the provincial PC nomination, then-leader Patrick Brown was forced to defend Gill's stance, saying the candidate had changed his views and

now supports gay rights "100 per cent," and that "a lot of Canadians have had their opinions evolve on this." He has harshly criticized the sex-ed curriculum instituted during Premier Kathleen Wynne's tenure, calling parts of it "disgusting." Ontario PC leader Doug Ford has promised to revert to the old sex-ed curriculum if his party is elected, saying they would create a new "age-appropriate" document

instead. The Liberals' changes to the curriculum include discussing same-sex relationships in Grade 3, and gender identity in Grade 6. Gill lives in Milton with his wife and three children. His bio on the party website says he was "involved in several family businesses in the manufacturing and hospitality industries" and "completed his studies in the executive MBA program" at Western University.

lution is to bury it beside the Great Lakes." Hayward is a registered massage therapist who has been running her own practice in Halton since 2003. Her professional website describes her work as "a custom blend of hands-on massage, Reiki, guided meditation, acupressure healing and crystal gemstone energy." She is a member of Toastmasters International and is studying social sciences at McMaster

University, working toward eventually becoming a psychotherapist. "Mental health inspires me personally and professionally," she said, adding she would like to see expanded coverage for talk-based therapy in the healthcare system. "The system is heavily slanted toward prescription care, but there's a lot of evidence to support more counselling hand-in-hand with medications." In its platform, the

Hayward lives in Hamilton as she studies at McMaster University but her family still lives in Milton. She says she remains very tied to the community. The Liberal party, said

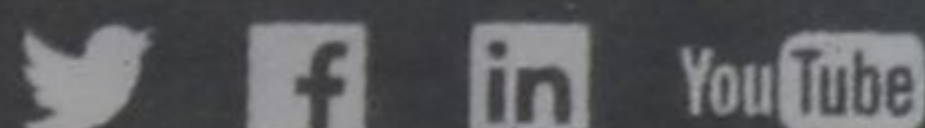

### NOTICE OF PESTICIDE USE

From May 14 to October 31, 2018, the Halton Region Health Department will be conducting a mosquito larviciding program under the direction of the Medical Officer of Health, Dr. Hamidah Meghani, to reduce the incidence of West Nile virus (WNV) in the City of Burlington, the Town of Halton Hills, the Town of Milton and the Town of Oakville.

#### Larviciding in standing water

Where monitoring indicates that mosquito larvae are present, the biological larvicide VectoBac 200G (PCP# 18158, granular) or VectoBac 1200L (PCP# 21062, liquid) will be applied to affected standing water on public lands in urban areas. Signs will be posted at each location indicating when and where the larvicide is applied.

#### Larviciding in catch basins

Where monitoring indicates that mosquito larvae are present, the larvicide Altosid Pellets (PCP# 21809, pellet) or Altosid XR Briquets (PCP# 27694, ingot) will be placed by hand into catch basins. All larvicides will be applied by Ministry of Environment and Climate Change licensed applicators or technicians.
