# It's party time! Milton Downtown Street Festival returns Saturday

Milton's summer kickoff bash is almost here.

The 12th annual Downtown Milton Street Festival returns this Saturday, June 2 along downtown Main Street — featuring a wide array of activities for the whole family.

Recently named one of the province's top-100 events by Festivals and Events Ontario, the daylong extravaganza — running from noon to 11:30 p.m. — features musical entertainment to suit all tastes on three different stages.

Highlighting this year's lineup is international U2 tribute act Desire, who'll close out the festival at 10 p.m. at the stage beside Troy's Diner.

Local bands such as Hawthorne and the Gavin McLeod Trio, as well as returning groups like The \$2 Bills, will take the stage.

The Milton Chinese Arts Society, Milton Rhythmic Gymnastics and Bollywood West Dance will be among the other performers.

Put on by presenting sponsor Rockwool, the event — which draws upwards of 90,000 each year — will once again include a kids' zone, a wide range of vendors and food stands.

Free public transit will be offered throughout the day.

Miltonians should note the farmers' market will not run that day in order for organizers to set up for the event.
