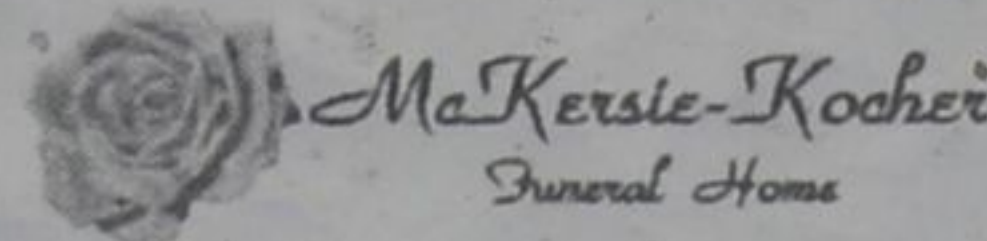

MCCORMACK, Frances Elizabeth

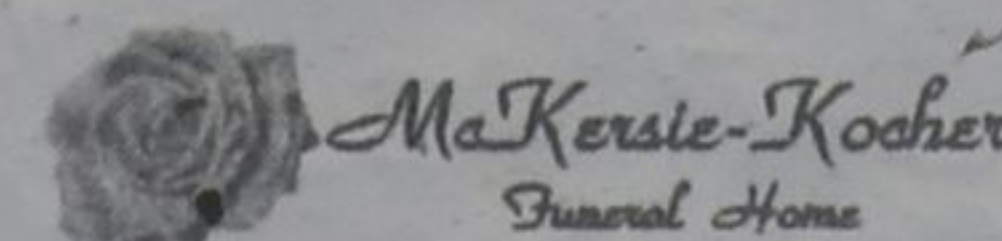

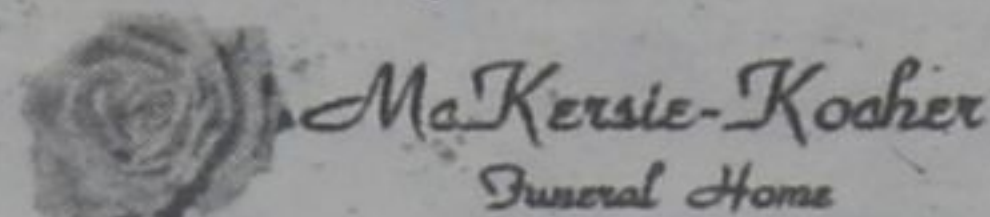

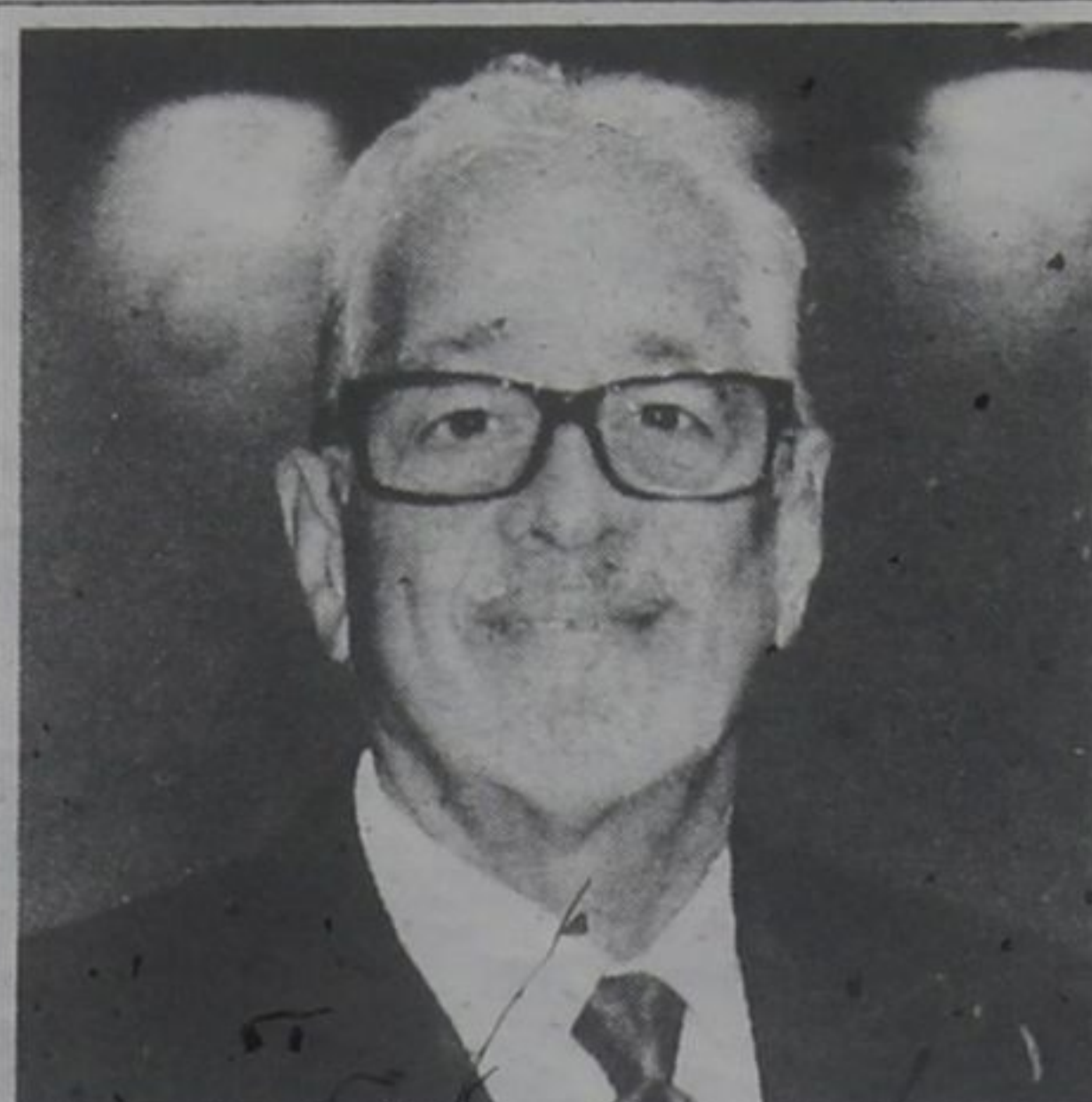
