Halton Region donates ambulances to St. John Ambulance

St. John Ambulance of Oakville-Milton Halton Hills has a new set of wheels thanks to the Halton Region. Halton Paramedic Services donated three decommissioned ambulances to St. John Ambulance services in Halton, with two vehicles going to the Burlington branch.

"It's a wonderful donation for us," said Tim Bauer, manager of the Oakville-Milton Halton Hills branch. "We use the ambulances as mobile first aid posts."

The branch attends over 350 events each year, ready to assist participants, visitors and residents for any sort of medical assistance. "We take care of anything from a scraped knee to a heart attack," said Bauer.

Before receiving donated ambulances from the region, St. John ambulance volunteers attended to people on foot.

Now, St. John ambulance will stock the vehicles with their medical equipment. The three ambulances are 2012 models with around 225,000 to 275,000 kilometres on the odometer.

"They're well-conditioned vehicles," said region chair Gary Carr. "They have a life cycle of seven or eight years."

St. John Ambulance will be at upcoming events like the Mac and Cheese Festival in Milton and the Highland Games in Georgetown.
