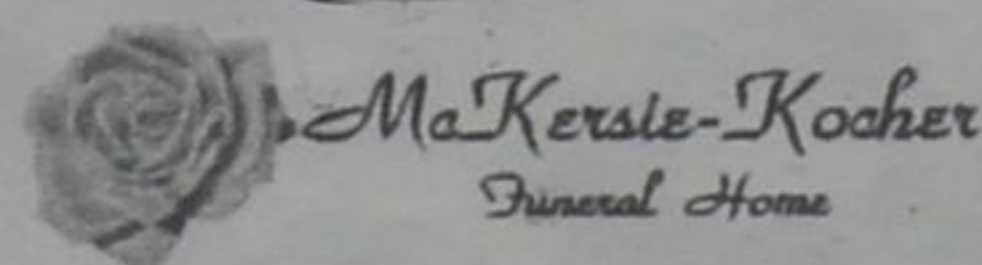

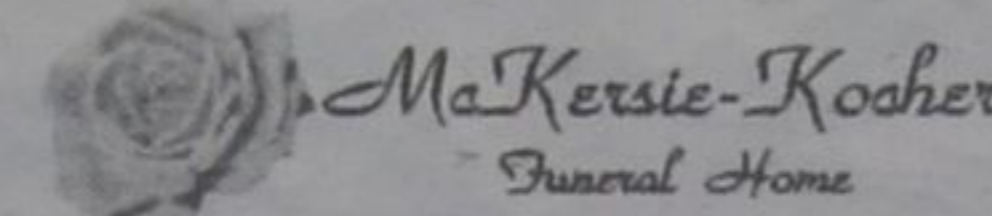
O'MALLEY, Edward Joseph
