

Gallingers serve Milton for 50 years

Gallinger Ford Lincoln is a name synonymous with Milton's car dealerships. The dealership, and family, has proudly served the community for more than 50 years – 40 of which have been at the current 655 Main St. location.

It all started in 1967 when former Toronto Studebaker dealer William (Bill) Gallinger and his wife, Evelyn, opened the Mercury Meteor dealership near the corner of Main and Ontario streets in the Milton Plaza.
