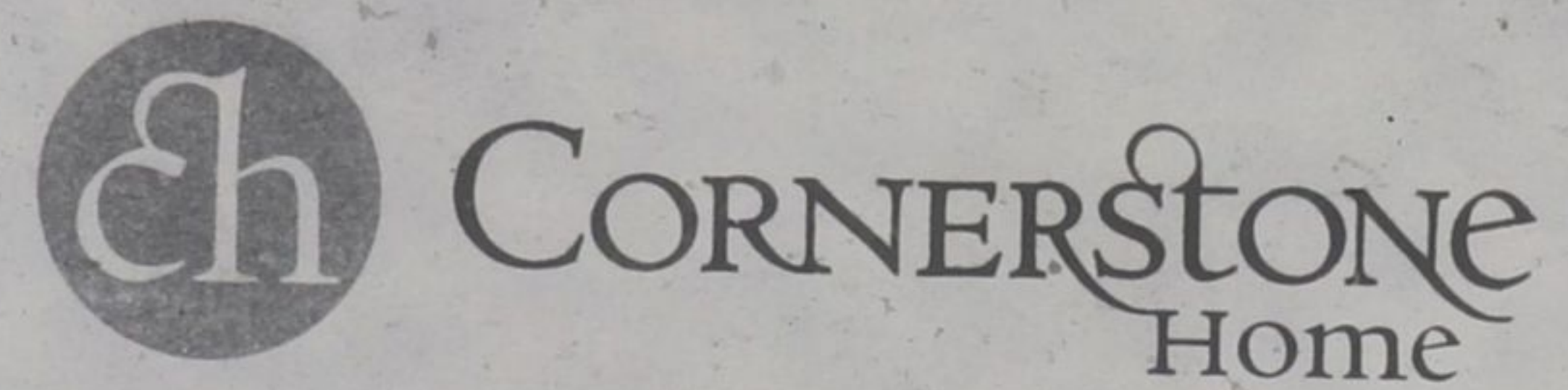

Will climate change one day make skating rinks a thing of the past? Join Laurier geographer Robert McLeman as he shares his findings and data to better understand how our winters are changing.

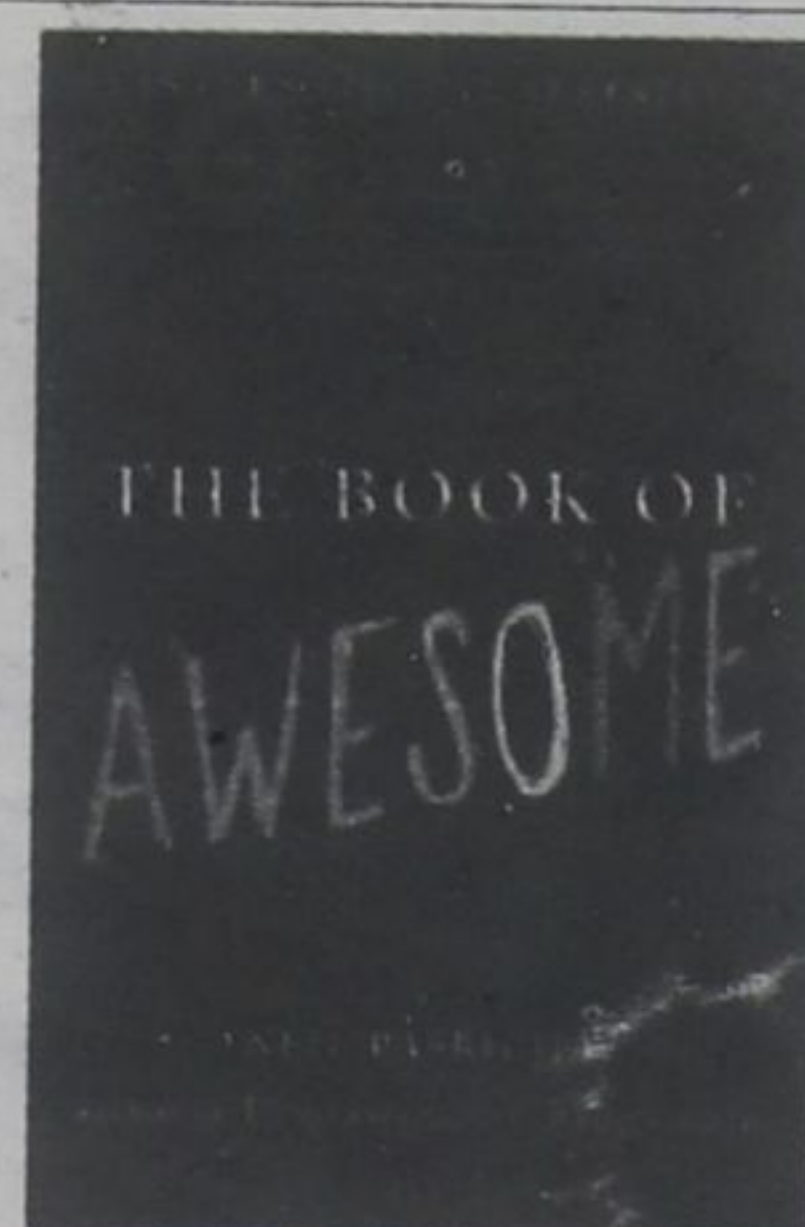
