## BILL MANN'S RETIREMENT IS EFFECTIVE AUG. 31

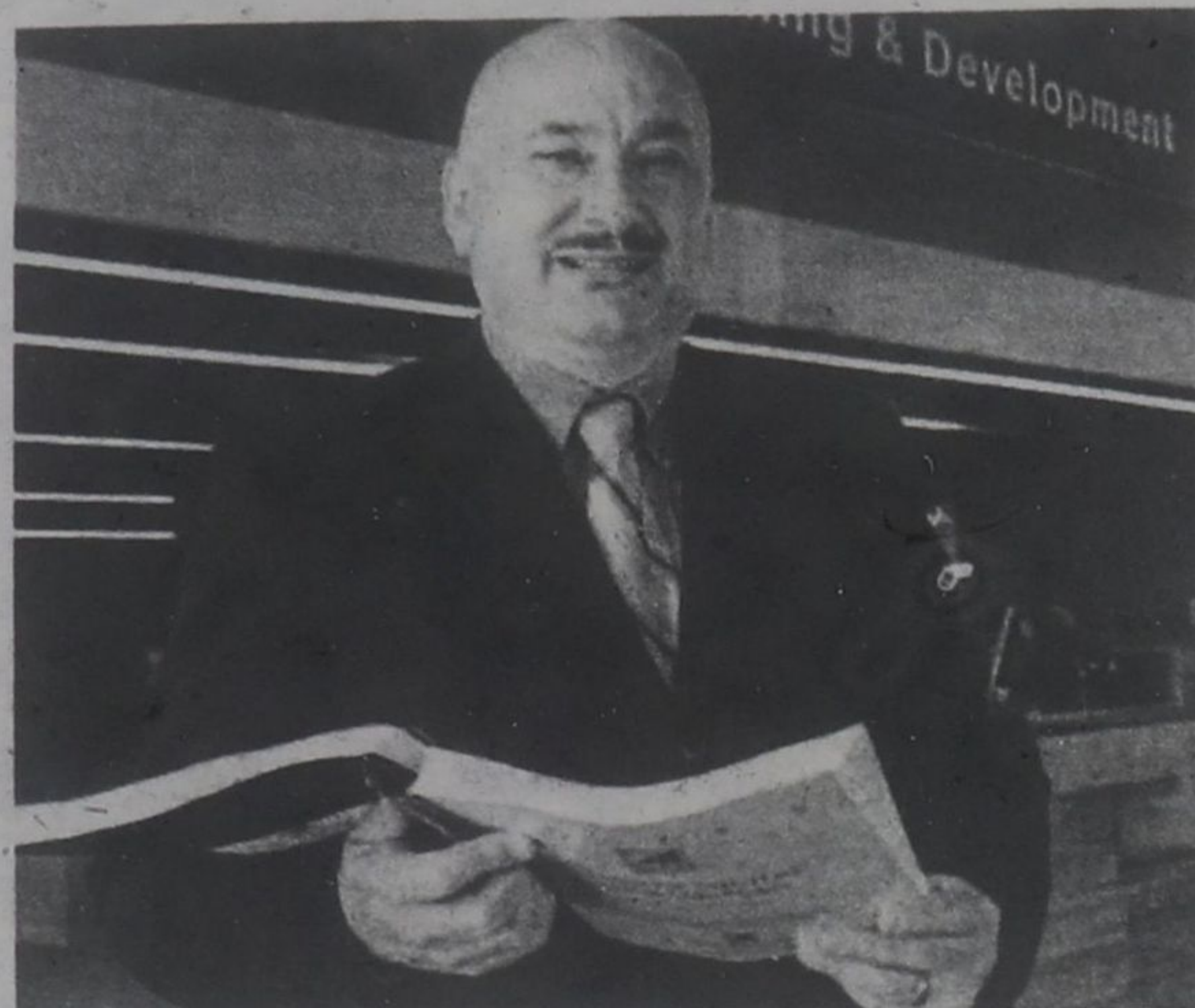
Bill Mann is set to retire from his job as chief administrative officer at the Town of Milton, a role that he has held for the past eight years.

will continue to shape the community for years to come," thanking him on behalf of residents for his dedication and commitment to the town, and wishing him the best in his retirement.

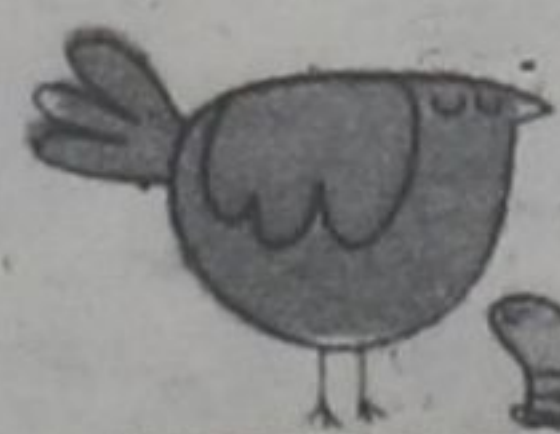
The town stated that Mann's retirement is effective Aug. 31.

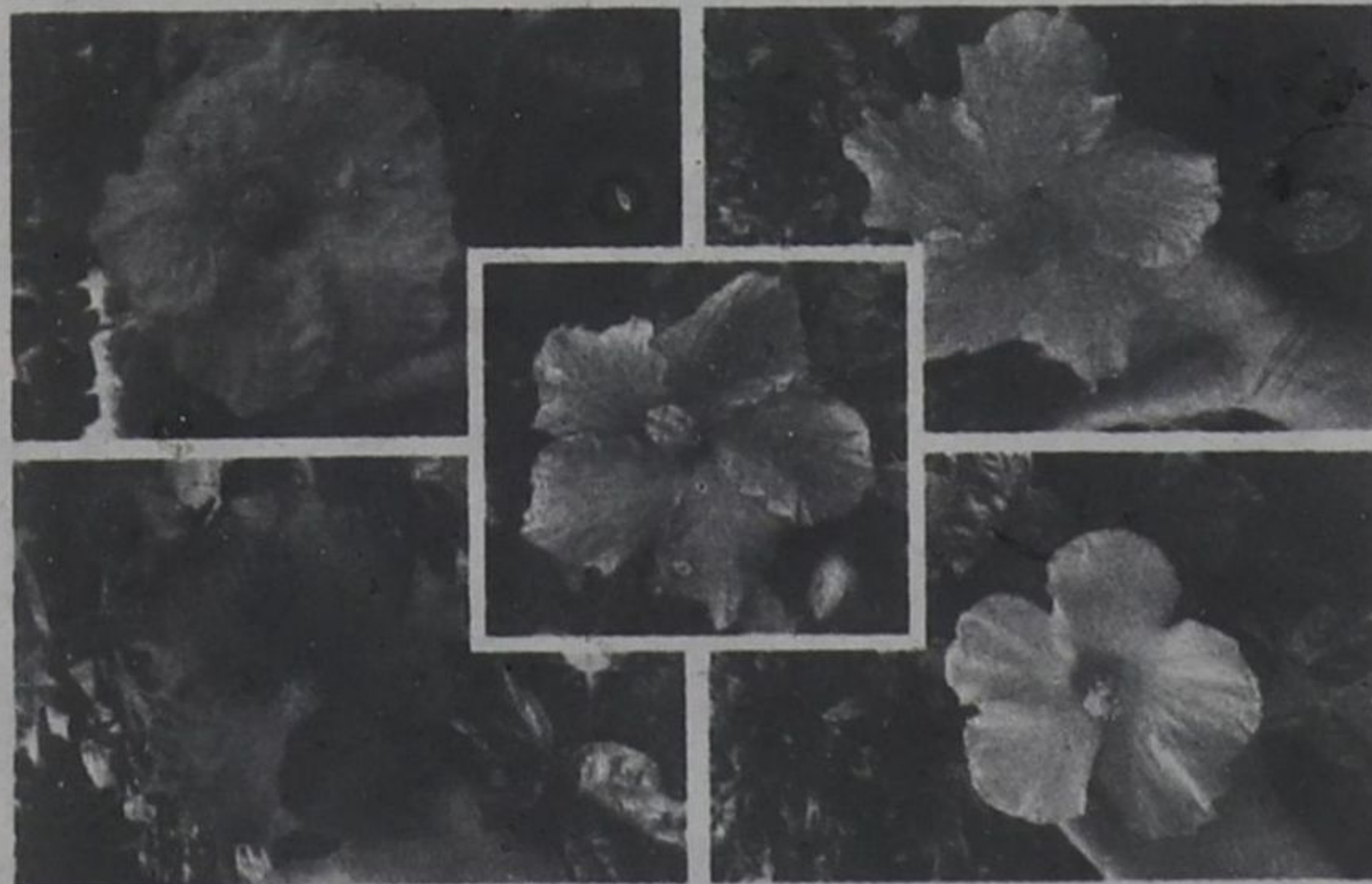
