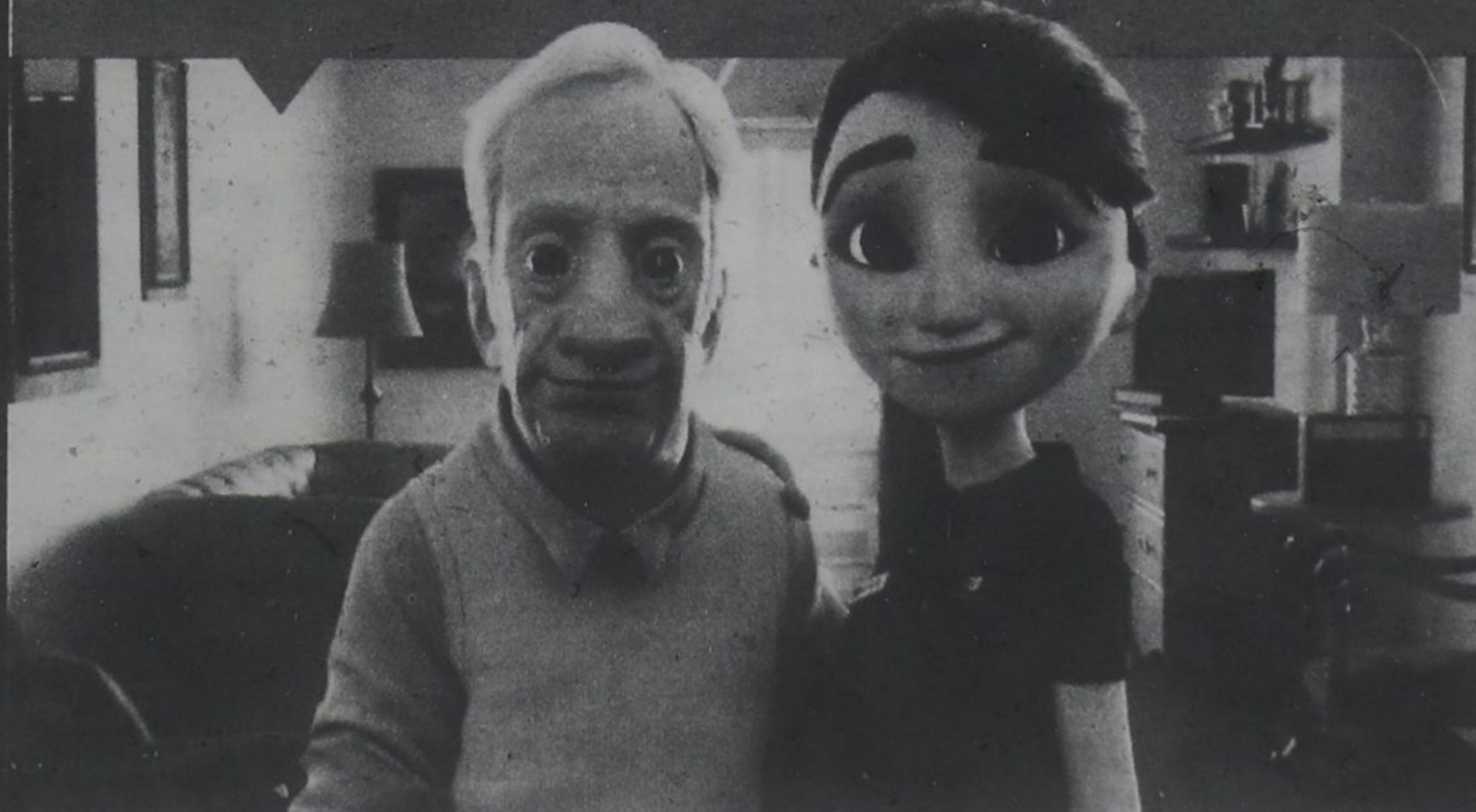
— bright, clean, pink and white and fun.
