RESIDENTS UPSET OVER DISCONTINUED GO BUS TO OAKVILLE

With the start of the new school year, students and parents are feeling the impact of Metrolinx's recent decision to cut several GO bus services in the region, in particular

Route 20 that connects Milton to Oakville.

"It's challenging trying to figure out how she's going to get there," said resident Michelle Fisher-Harris, referring to her 17-year-old daughter who just started her first year at Sheridan College in Oakville.

As an alternative, the provincial transit agency suggests riders take GO routes 25 or 29 from the Highway 401 park-and-ride at Regional Road 25 to Erin Mills Transitway Station in Mississauga - and then transfer to Route 46 to Sheridan College.

But Fisher-Harris said

it's "not fair for everyone to have to transfer three or four times and takes two-and-a-half hours to go 15 kilometres."

Fisher-Harris, who works in Mississauga, said it's not ideal for her to drive her daughter to Oakville every day and then make her way back


