

HALTON POLICE BOARD NAMES NEXT DEPUTY CHIEF

PROMOTION CAME FROM WITHIN THE HALTON POLICE

The Halton Regional Police Service has found its next deputy chief.

The Halton Police Services Board recently announced that Supt. Jeff Hill will be promoted to the role of deputy chief of police.

Hill will join Chief Stephen Tarner and Deputy Chief Roger Wilkie in leading the police service.

"The police board is confident that Deputy Chief Jeff Hill will enable us to continue to deliver and raise the standard of community and staff safety and well-being to which we are dedicated," said Oakville Mayor and Halton Police Board chair Rob Burton.

Burton said Hill was chosen following an extensive internal search for an individual who would fulfil the mission and vision of the Halton Police Services Board in supporting the chief, the police service, and the Halton community.

The board chair noted Hill's broad experience, exemplary leadership skills and ability to connect meaningfully with community partners will make him a most effective deputy chief and will strengthen the service's leadership bench.

In his role as acting deputy chief of regional operations, Hill oversaw approximately 500 police service members in the areas of regional investigative services, corporate services, human resources, emergency services training, court services and communications.

As superintendent for regional investigative services, Hill was responsible for developing and overseeing investiga-

...tive processes and an operating budget of more than \$21 million.

Tanner said through community collaboration, Hill also led

important initiatives, including a complete review of how the service responds to survivors of domestic violence, resulting in significant improvements to the victims service unit.

"As chief of police I am pleased to announce that Supt. Jeff Hill will become our next deputy chief of police. Jeff will join Deputy Chief Roger Wilkie and I on the executive management team. Deputy Chief Hill brings to the position a great deal of experience from across our police service, including a considerable amount of time as the commander of human resources and most recently as the commander of our regional investigative services, which oversees homicide, sexual assault, domestic violence, intelligence, drugs and morality, human trafficking, forensic identification services, and regional frauds," said Tanner.

"I continue to be greatly impressed with the high quality of

senior leaders that we have within and throughout the Halton Regional Police Service. This was an internal selection process which involved other highly qualified candidates from within the Halton police who have made this service what it is today and will continue to lead us into the future."

Hill holds a BA in justice services from the University of Guelph-Humber and will complete the police leadership program at the University of Toronto's Rotman School of Management this month.

He is currently a member of several Halton police committees, including the sexual assault advisory committee and the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police organized crime committee.

Hill has been actively involved with Halton Women's Place, Food4Kids, and SAVIS (Sexual Assault and Violence Intervention Services).
