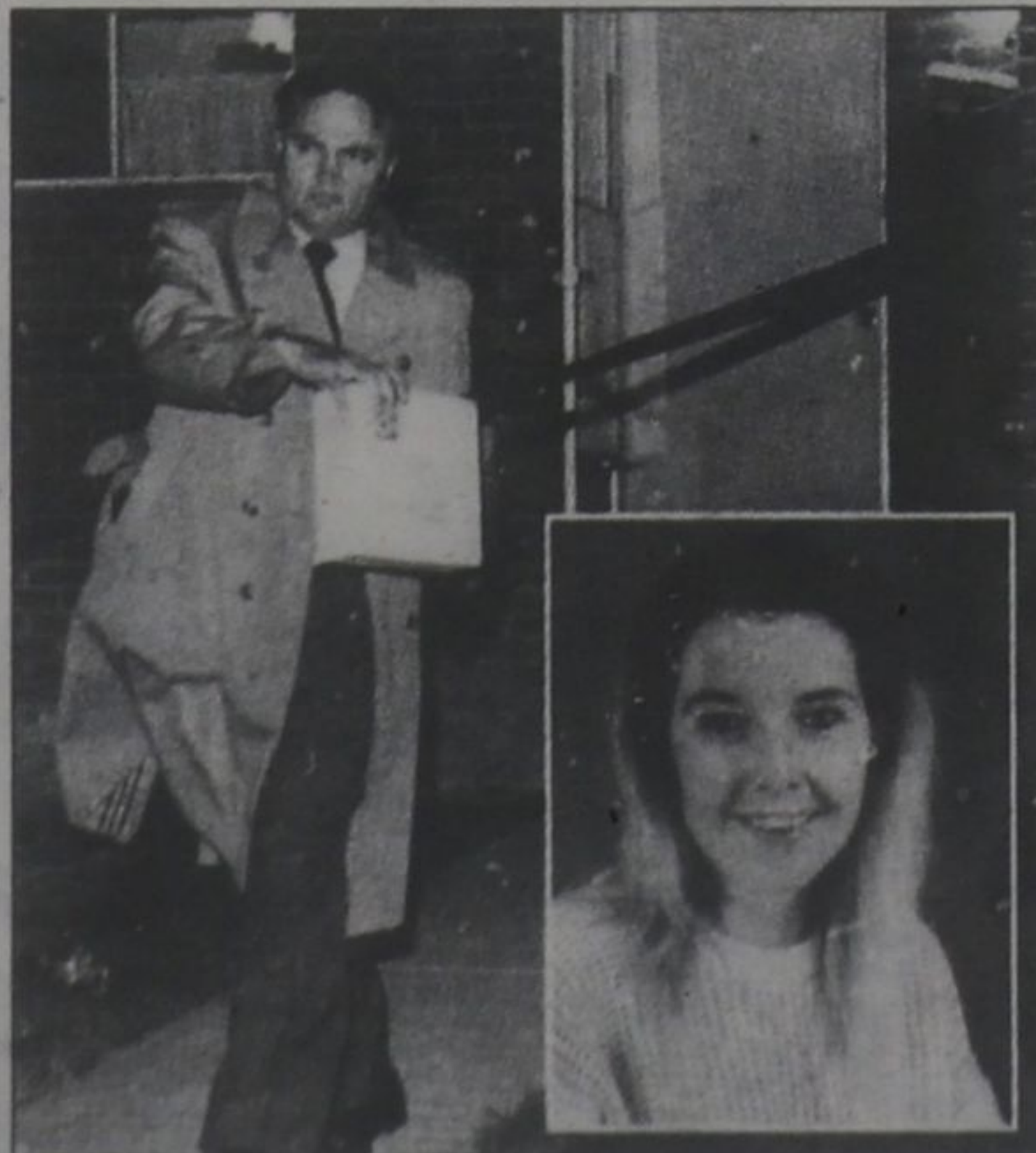
BURLINGTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA - RUSSIAN TREASURES
