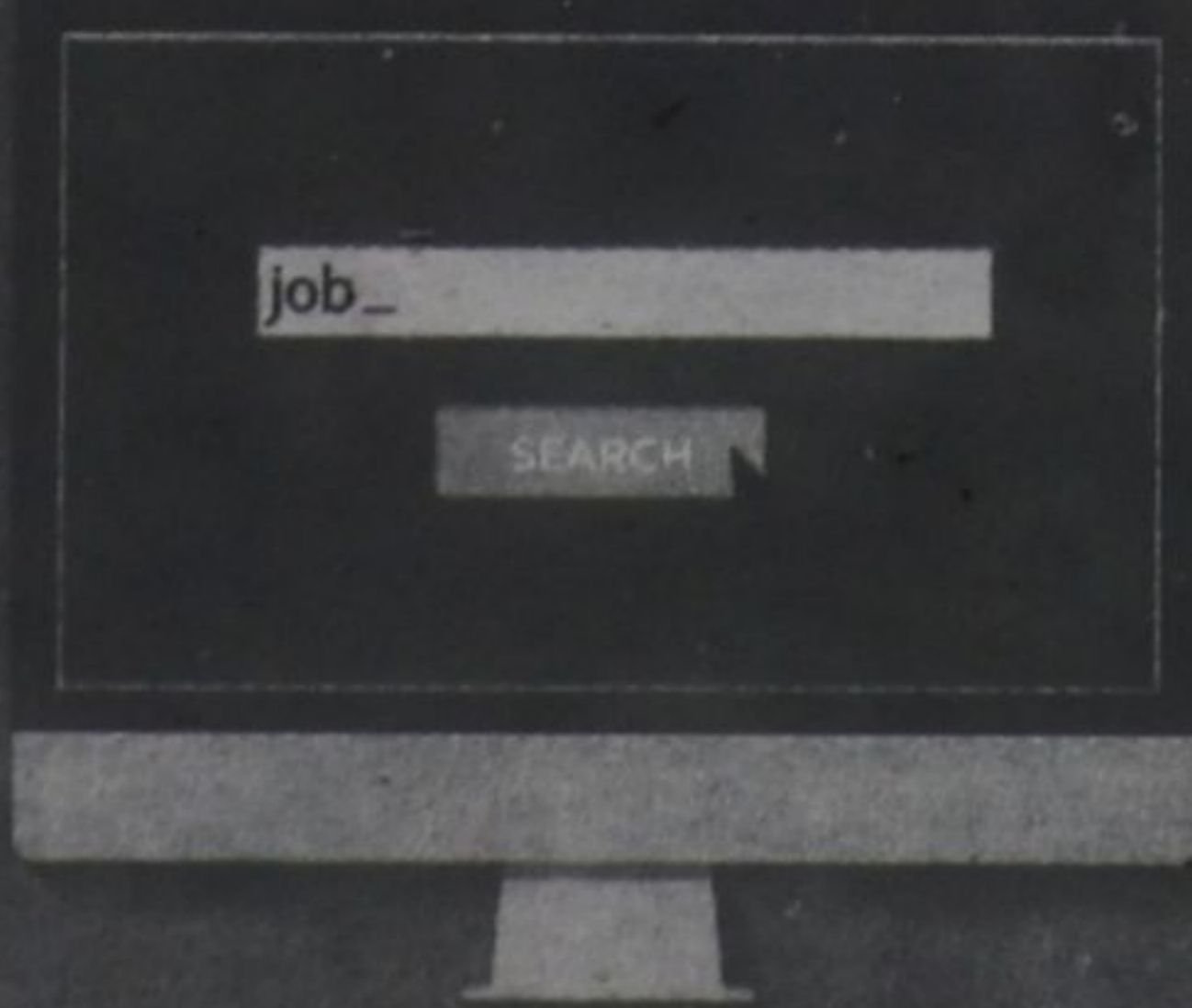


LIBERTA, Alfredo

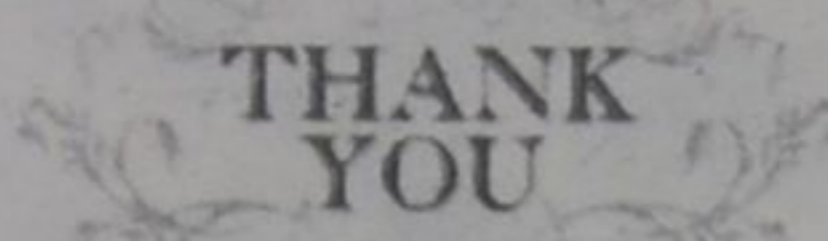
