THE SCOLD'S BRIDLE.

Brutal Punishment to Which Women

Were Once Subjected. The brank, or scold's bridle, or gos-Womanhood, False Gods, and Mistaken sip's bridle, was neither more nor less han a muzzle. It was in general use o Great Britain from the sixteenth to the eighteenth century, and in Scotland as well women were muzzled for 2 1-30 certain offenses, some at least of them 1 tt. 1-5 more imaginary than real. The instrunent of torture, even a dog's leather muzzle, is uncomfortable. How much more the scold's muzzle! It consisted. according to a high authority, Mr. W. Jewitt, of a kind of crown or framebrork of fron, which was locked upon the head, and it was armed in front with a gag, a plate or a sharp cutting knife or point, which was placed in the poor woman's mouth so as to prevent her moving her tongue, or it was so "When he paid his bill for a fifty !
