Weeds and the Seed Law.

A bulletin has been issued by the Seed Branch of the Department of Agriculture, Oltawa, giving a full reprint of the Seed Control Act. 1911. which is the law governing the sale of ? seeds in Canada. This Act. with the regulations of the Governor in council names the weeds which are considered most noxious and are particularly legislated against and defines the standards of quality in regard to purity and germination to which seed of various kinds must conform when sold for seeding purposes. The standards for four grades of timothy, red clover. alsike and alfalfa seed are given and full information regarding the law as applied to farmers and the way in which it may be used for their pro-
