The county councils of Halton and Peel are asked to pay the rent of a room in Acton used by Police Magistrate Moore as his office. They object to payment. The claim is based on Sec. 39 of The Magistrates Act, 1922, which reads: "Where a Police Magistrate is appointed with jurisdiction over a county, it shall be the duty of the corporation of the county to provide a suitable office, furniture, stationery and other accommodation for the Police Magistrate in accordance with the regulations made under this part." Nothing is said about where the office shall be. The offices of county officials, no matter where they may live, are usually in the court houses in the county towns. In Halton the Sheriff lives at Norval, but his office is in the court house here and he has to come here to attend to his duties, as did two nonresident Registrars in the past. Is there any good reason why a Police Magistrate's office should not be in the court house, like those of other county officials? If this were made the fact in Halton and Peel and the magistrate notified that the office would be at his disposal, with fire, light and attendance, it should meet the regulation and end all trouble.

Municipal Elections.

At the nominations at Georgetown last week the old council was reelected by acclamation as follows: Mayor, LeRoy Dale; Reeve, D. McIntyre; Councillors, Kelly, Ashburnurst, Parry, Campbell, Duncan, Long.

At Acton George Barber and Ames Mason were nominated for the township. The remaining members were elected by acclamation: Messrs. Atkinson, Holmes, Thorntun and Parker. So were the four School Trustees: Messrs. W. J. Read, L. Williams, Geo Agnew and Ebenezer Benwick. The polling took place on Monday, when Mr. Agnew was elected by a majority of 153.

County Court and Sessions.

The County Court and General Sessions for the county of Halton opened on Tuesday before His Honor, Judge E. E. Edel. There were no civil cases to try, but there was a criminal one.

The King v. Roffey. The prisoner, George Roffey, was indicted for the violation of a young girl. The evidence was not of a nature to publication. The evidence for the defense was principally from the trial. The trial was long and the court did not close until after 11 p.m., when the jury, after two hours' deliberation, reported that they had come to a verdict. Three of its members, it is said, stood out for an acquittal. The prisoner was remanded for another trial at the Sessions in June next. W. L. Dick, Crown Attorney, conducted the prosecution. T. A. Hall, his defense.

The prisoner was released on bail yesterday.

I. I. O. Convention.

The convention of the United Farmers of Ontario opened in Massey Hall, Toronto, yesterday. The discussion of future political action will take place during the three days of the meeting. The paper calling for a discussion of the matter asks that the U.F.O. should in future hold aloof from such matters, and that any director who accepts a political nomination, whether for Provincial and Federal field should be compelled to resign. Judging from the record so far, it will earn as the drift of the U.F.O. organization is towards a more or less radical action rather than political. Hon. E. C. Drury is not a delegate. He sat in the gallery. He cannot take part in the discussion, as a resolution adopted yesterday stated, but persons other than an agricultural delegate could have an opportunity to discuss any of the resolutions.

Millions of Wilts.

The visitors of Somerset House, London, England, are granted to take along with wills and copies of wills, and with each will, death certificates, to the proprieites of the Board of Works, which is faced with a problem of finding further accommodation for them.

Built in 1776 on the site formerly occupied by the palace of the Duke of Somerset, who was beheaded in 1652, the present edifice has housed in turn the Royal Academy, the Royal Society, the Society of Antiquaries, and the Geological Society.

Amongst the millions of with preserved are those of Shakespeare, Sir Isaac Newton, Dr. Johnson, the Duke of Wellington, and many other famous people.

Mountain Peaks in Quebec.

The altitude above sea level of the principal peaks in the Eastern Townships of the Province of Quebec are: Owl's Head, 2,425 feet; Orford, 2,580; Round Top, Sutton Range, 3,180; McGautie, 3,640. The mountain tops in the Gaspé Peninsula are somewhat higher. Table Top has an altitude of about 4,000 feet, and is supposed to be the highest in the Province of Quebec. Another in Gaspe is Richardson, about 3,900 feet high. There are many elevations in the country north of the St. Lawrence river, forming the Saguenay and Chicoutimi districts, but their height is not known as this country has not yet been thoroughly surveyed.

The first sitting of the Supreme Court of Canada was held at Ottawa.


