Now he has evolved a process which allows this to be done on a large scale at a remarkably low cost. A factory nearing completion in the neighborhood of great sea lakes in Siberia will, it is estimated, yield an annual seaweed

seaweed can be converted into paper in less than half an hour. Sixteen different kinds of paper, as well as cardboard and glue, have already been obtained from seaweed, and the chief waste product is a fireproof, substance that can be manufactured
