Earliest Corn Grown in Peru, Scientists Report

Corn on the cob first appeared in the damp savannahs of South America and attained its present form under cultivation by the farmers of prehistoric Peru.

The origin of maize, or Indian corn, long has been a puzzle to botanists and archeologists. It was due to a single gene mutation from the wild state, must originally have had "two essential characteristics" of pod-corn to survive in the wilderness.

Troubled by the total absence of wild pod-corn in Peru, the greatest center for cultivation of maize, the scientists looked long before they discovered the very ancient times.

Their conclusion was that Peru's able farmers soon cleared their maize fields of the undesirable pod-corn, which appears abundantly in Central America, where the Indians were less civilized and less careful of the purity of their crops.
