Stand 'Aging' Long Time A Welsh rabbit made with good, old cheese will not give anybody a nightmare.

"Old" is a relative term in cheese. Some of the soft cheeses ripen in a month; some of the hard cheeses, are at their best only after years in storage. The United States government, in its purchases of American, or Cheddar-type, cheese for distribuas the minimum time which this cheese should age to be fit for human consumption. But this cheese will stand aging indefinitely.


