Affirmative Plebiscite Vote Calls For All-Out War

Ontario was on record Tuesday with an 84 per cent. decision of its civilian electorate that the Dominion government should not be hampered by any pledges or commitments about use of Canada's manpower in any theatre of this "survival war."

The decision was general in all but two of the province's 82 constituencies. Prescott and Russell, which contain a large French Canadian population, went negative.
