D. Pelletterio Wins Dairy Man Award

David Pelletterio, Ash and Mildred Parkinson, Hillsburgh, were named Dairy Maid and Dairy Man from among the Ontario junior farmers as having contributed the most to dairy farming, last week at the first Canadian Dairy Day near Alma.

The competition was sponsored by the Ontario Milk Distributors' Association to emphasize the importance of farm youth in the Ontario Dairy industry.

The awards were made by M. G. Simpson, executive secretary of the association, who said: "If the dairy industry in Ontario is to continue to thrive and operate successfully, we must do everything in our power to ensure that the ties between our farm youth and the dairy industry are strengthened."

He said the award would be an annual one.

The dairy day, sponsored by the dairy branch of the Ontario Department of Agriculture, was held on the farm of Mervin Shantz, just outside Alma.

Exhibitions of loafing barns, milking parlors, various types of feed storage and other things pertaining to the dairy industry were staged. Farmers attending the show got the latest tips on milk production.

Deputy Agriculture Minister C. D. Graham, one of the speakers, urged farmers to continue the struggle for quality food production in Ontario, a leading province in that regard.
