RUBBER TRACTOR SPRING


Rubber springs which take the "jerks" and "bumps" out of riding a tractor, are reported in The Financial Post. They consist of a thick layer of especially compounded rubber sandwiched between two metal plates. The rubber is fastened to metal by a special brass plating process. Mounted in pairs on a tractor seat, the springs cushion initial shock and level out the sharp rebound which normally occurs with the use of a heavy steel spring.
