**Milton
 Recollections**

Fifty Years Ago

Taken from the Issue of the Canadian Champion of March 29, 1900

A fairly well attended meeting of members of the Halton Agricultural Society was held at the Town Hall on Saturday, to consider the proposed increase in the size of the Fair Grounds. A resolution was carried which authorized the directors to purchase one and one-half acres on the south-east side of the grounds and erect upon it a 60 ft. by 24 ft. catshed. The price of the land will be \$160 and it was figured that \$500 would cover it and the expense of building, etc.

The directors were therefore empowered to pay off the present mortgage of the grounds of \$1000 with interest at 6 per cent and give a new one for \$1500 with interest at 5 per cent, to a gentleman who had offered to lend the money. At future fairs, the cattle and pigs will be exhibited as well as kept in the new enclosure.

This morning as jailer Vanallen was shutting the large gates opening into the jail yard in the rear of the Registry office, a gust of wind slammed them suddenly. Mr. Vanallen was thrown about five feet and fell heavily on the ice hurting one knee so badly that he had to be carried into his rooms. Fortunately no bones were broken and it is hoped Mr. Vanallen will be alright shortly.

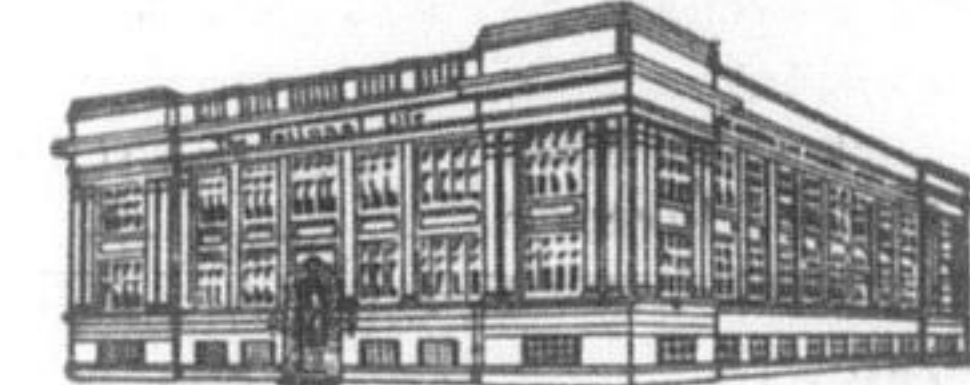
