Hello Homemakers! We're making no statements as to what is the traditional Strawberry Shortcake.

SUNSHINE SHORTCAKE

- 6 egg yolks 2/3 cup sugar 1 tsp. lemon juice 1 1/2 cups cake flour 1/2 cup pineapple juice 1 tsp. baking powder 6 egg whites 1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 cup sugar

HONEY BISCUIT CAKE

- 3 cups cleaned strawberries 1 tsp. tapioca custard powder 1 tsp. grated orange rind 1/2 cup honey 1 cup pastry flour 2 tps. baking powder 1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 cup shortening 1 beaten egg 3 tps. milk 2 tps. honey 1 tsp. orange rind

4. Spread dough over berries. Bake in preheated electric oven of 400 degrees for about 15 minutes.

- 1. Heat 1/2 cup pineapple juice and 1/2 cup other fruit juice. Stir in a paste of 1 tps. cornstarch and about 2 tps. water. 2. Add 1/2 tsp. slivered candied ginger and 1 tps. butter. 3. Cook 10 minutes, then chill. Add 1 quart clean strawberries and 1/2 cup cubed pineapple. 4. Slice Sunshine Cake crosswise: add layer of fruit, then place on the top half and add remaining fruit.

TAKE A TIP 1. Spread picked-over berries (strawberries with stems on) in a shallow pan and store in the central part of refrigerator.

4. Fresh sour cherries, pitted and stewed in a light syrup, make a delicious compote dessert served with graham crackers.

THE QUESTION BOX Mrs. J. R. asks: How to keep cookies crisp? Answer: Store in wide mouthed glass jar or crock and remove cover once or twice a day.

Miss B. L. asks: How to keep marshmallows soft? Answer: Store marshmallows in a covered quart jar, using rubber band, then adjust the glass top.

Mrs. M. M. asks: How to keep cress from turning soft and yellow after cut? Answer: Store cress and parsley in a pint jar. Add 1/2 inch water to jar and then tuck stems into water.
