High School Exam Results Announced

The results of the Milton High School examinations are announced in this issue of the Champion. The marks of all students are being mailed to them this week. Parents should ask to see them.

Where students failed in more than two subjects they will be required to register in the same form for the next year but may proceed to the work in any subject where the timetable will permit them to get all the classes. The practice of allowing students to take three or four classes out of a total of five is being discontinued.

In Upper School there will be offered courses in English, Modern History, Three Mathematics (Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry), Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Latin, French, and German if required.

In Middle School there will be courses in English, Ancient History, Modern History, Algebra, Geometry, Agriculture 1, Agriculture 2, Latin, French, German.

In Lower School the courses offered will include English, British History, Canadian History, Geography, Mathematics, Agricultural Science, Guidance. All students of Grades 9 and 10 will be required to take Shop or Household Economics. Music and Art will be optional subjects.

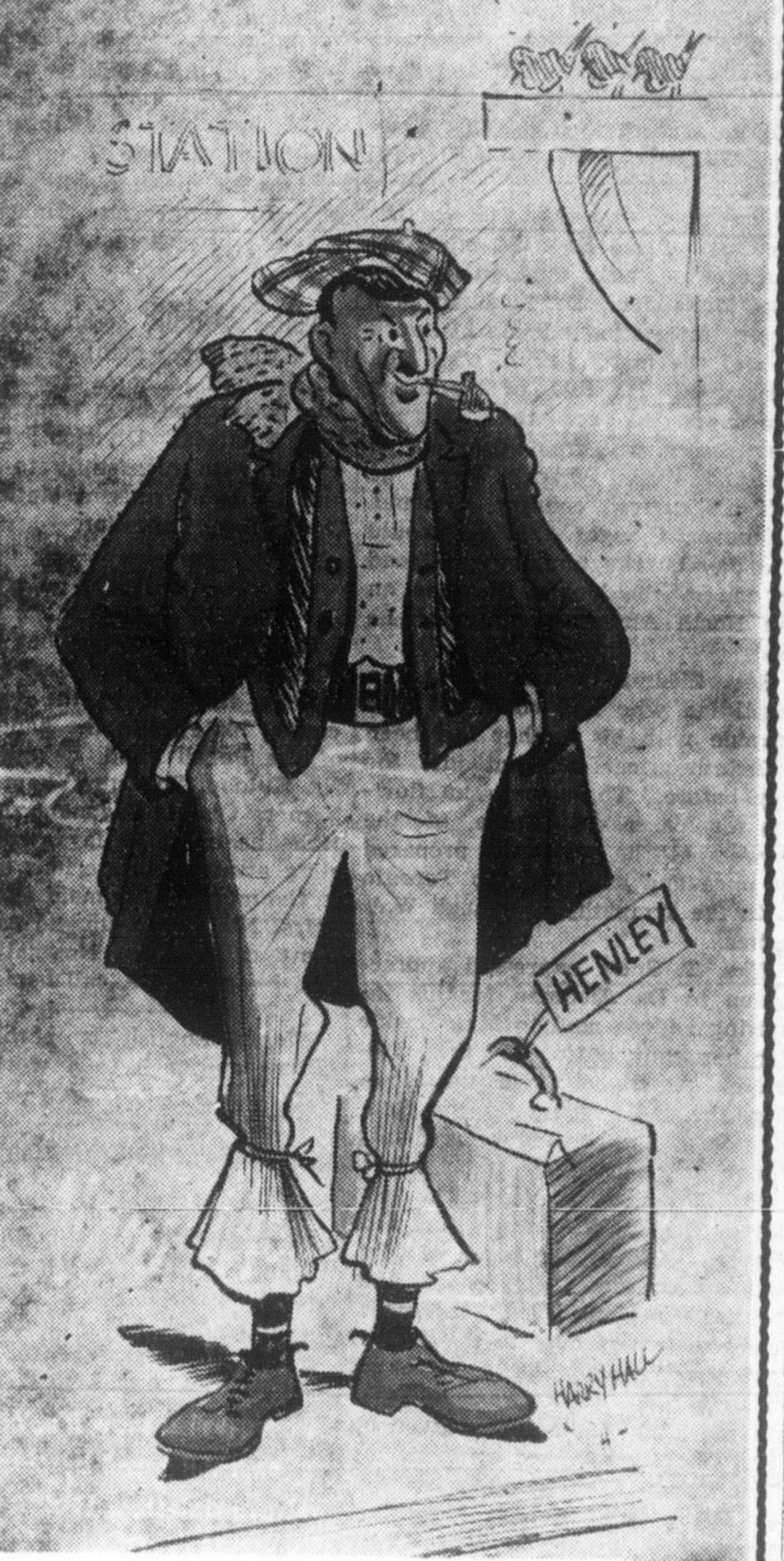
