In general any difficulties encountered are largely due to misunderstanding on the part of a few cattle owners. In order to clarify the situation we would make the following observations:

1. As a result of the petitions signed by 90% of Halton's cattle owners all four township Councils passed by-laws making calfhood vaccination obligatory.

2. By calfhood vaccination is meant of inoculation of all heifer calves between 6 and 9 months of age. The only exception under the Act is in the case of "Herds Listed under the Federal Government's


