one person in every forty, based on colors. Then too, it is wise to use a comparative U.S. figures. The leading cause of home accidents is falls, (two out of three) followed by injuries due to fire, and burns.

The principal place of occurrence for home falls, or for all home accidents for that matter, is in the bedroom. Next in line are kitchens, stairs, and bathrooms.

Today one of the prime concerns in industry is accident prevention. Companies have found that an organized safety program can bring results. For instance, at the plants of Canadian Industries Limited a planned program to prevent accidents has resulted in a reduction in accident frequency of over 90 per cent. during a 26-year period. But, the safety state of mind cannot be picked up at the door when the employee enters the plant to start work and left there when he goes home. It must become part of his whole life.

Some of the things industry has learned about preventing accidents can be used at home. Take accidental falls, for example, which are also a leading cause of injuries in industry. Experience shows they can be prevented by taking mea-

Trimming Your Tree

Let's say your tree is 6 feet in height and 41/2 feet wide at the base. (See Figure.) The formula would work like this: 6 x 41/2 x 3


