The manure piles would be removed every 10 days and he had suggested it was "still too infrequent." A surface covering on the land fill area was also suggested and the fair board agreed to contribute filling from a ditch that needed widening.

Deputy-Reeve Pettit asked if lime could be used to stop the smell of the manure but she was told at the fair grounds that lime would make the manure unfit for mushroom growing.

A letter from the parking authority said the members met eight times since January and reviewed 15 properties north and south on Main St. They stated they have a master plan for draining, filling and hardtopping the areas but the ground has to be sufficiently dry before operations can begin.

Some work done by Mayor Sid Childs that the town foreman has already done some work on the weeds in the Fallingbrook area but operations have not yet been completed.

The OPP quarters in the basement of the Children's Aid Society building is getting cramped a number. There have been quite a number of additions to the force since the present headquarters was picked and another addition of a constable, making eight, forces the OPP to seek quarters elsewhere.
