Snorkle Blamed In Water Death

Tim Milloy, past chairman of the Milton Safety Council, attended an inquest at Southhampton Ontario last week, into the drowning of a young boy as a result of improper use of a snorkle apparatus.

Mr. Milloy was at the scene of the drowning a few miles south of Port Elgin. The lifeguard noticed that the boy was missing and began to dive for him. The boy was recovered about 15 minutes after he had been under the water and was pulled into a boat

and taken ashore. Since he had been practicing mouth to mouth respiration with his family, Mr. Milloy had the special tube in his car and was able to get it and immediately Small Acreages, Lots began to work on the victim. An anaesthetist who happened to be on the scene administered heart shocks while they were waiting

for the ambulance.

Massage Heart Mr. Milloy continued to work on the boy until he arrived at the hospital, where an emergency operation was performed the heart massaged. He never recovered consciousness and was pronounced dead after

the operation failed. At the inquest it was learned Phone 203 that the boy had been diving with the snorkle tube in eight to c-11 ten feet of water. The jury recommended that the sale of the snorkle devices be banned. Mr. Milloy pointed out that the snorkle tubes were safe enough if they were used the proper way. He said that they were not to be used for diving, only while floating on top of the water.
