Open First Central Library

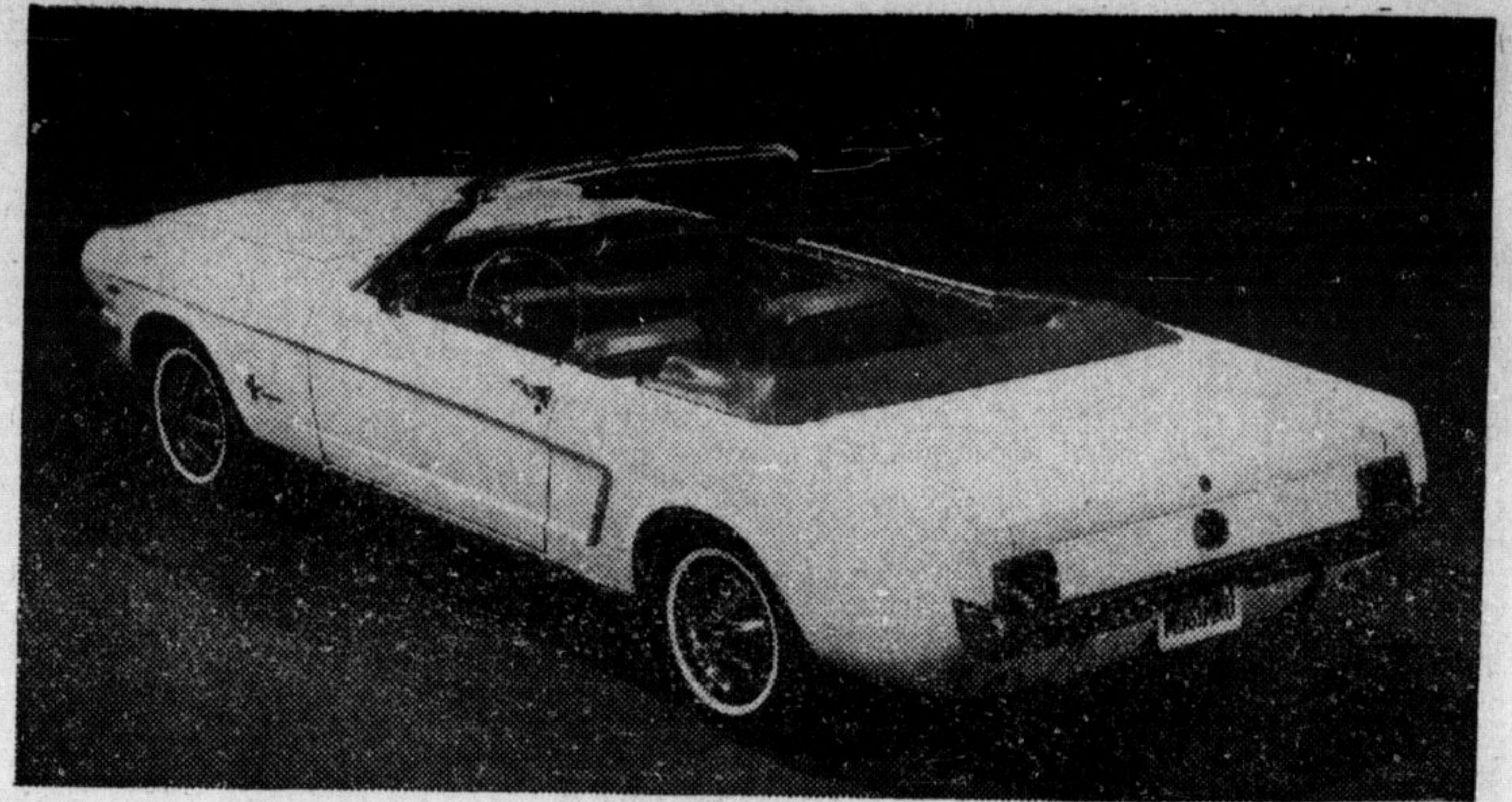
A special ceremony Monday afternoon, highlighted by a "ribbon snipping" officially opened the W. I. Dick School central library. The new library presently is stocked with 400 books, but 600 new volumes are currently on order.

Milton Public School Board chairman G. C. Gowland snipped a red ribbon to mark the official opening and Public School Inspector W. L. McNeil spoke briefly, commending the work of the Board and school principal Raymond Long.

Mr. McNeil thanked Mr. Long for "his leadership in setting up the new library." He noted that the new facility was just another example of how the Milton Public School Board strives to give the students of the town a chal-

lenging and complete education. He urged the students to make good use of the new library, and to read often and read well.

Public School Board Trustee Don Stinson stamped the first book to leave the new library. This is the first central library set up in the Milton Public School system, with books from all the classes being moved to one central location where they can be borrowed by the students in much the same manner as they do at the public library.



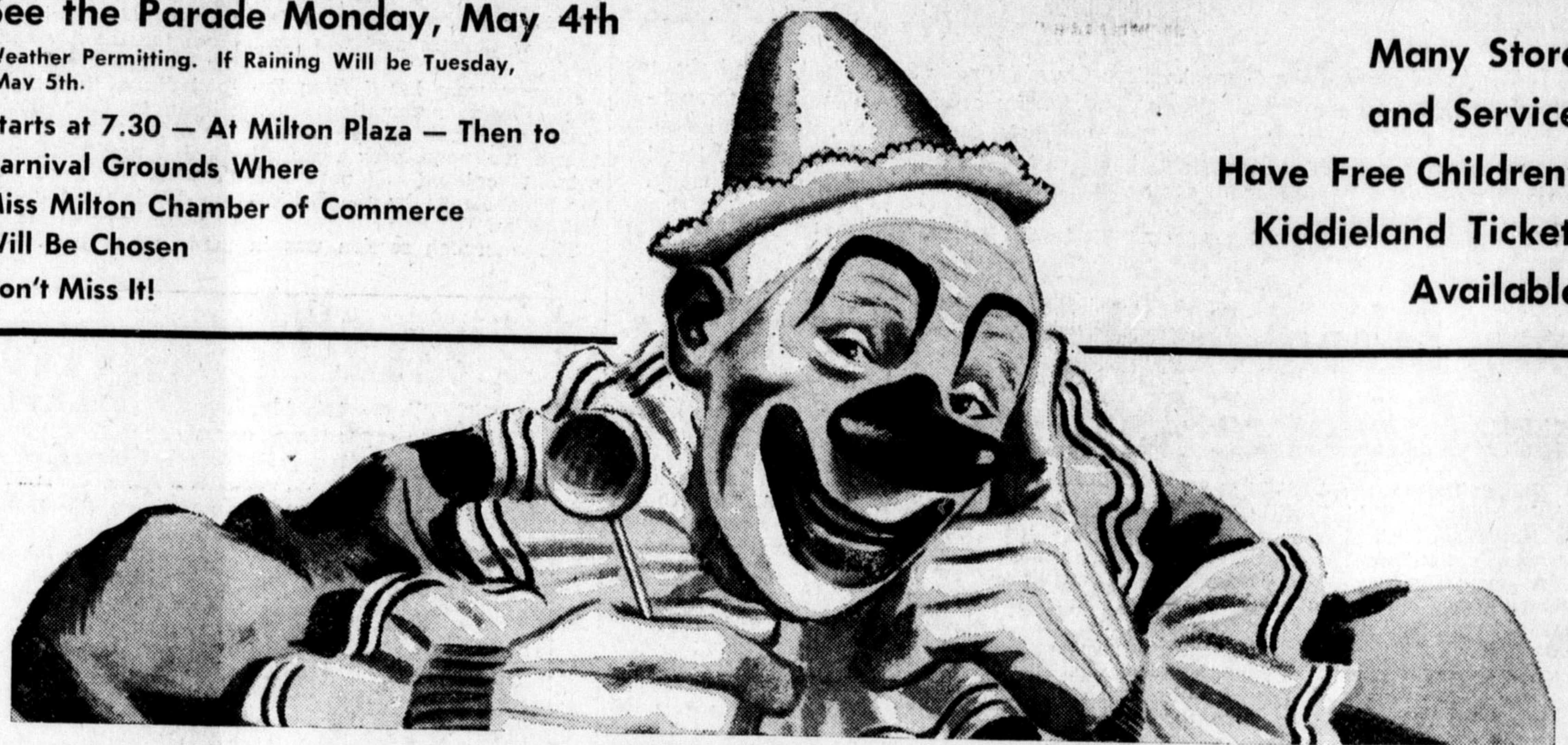
