

HARLEY...to HALTON

The amendments to the National Housing Act I discussed in last week's column have passed the House of Commons without change and will now go to the Senate. They should receive Royal Assent within a week and be available for the purposes mentioned such as urban renewal. The changes in the Farm Credit Act are being debated now.

There are three measures to complete in the House of Commons before we move to the flag resolution. These are (1) Farm Credit Act as above; (2) amendments to the B.N.A. Act which will be presented when the provinces agree. I now understand that the province of Quebec has to pass this in its Legislature this week and then it will be available for the House of Commons. (3) Interim supply will be necessary for the government to pay its bills for the month of June.

Withdrawn Opposition

A very unusual thing happened in the House of Commons several days ago. A question of privilege was raised by the Leader of the New Democratic Party against the Leader of the Opposition, Mr. Diefenbaker, who had made a speech in Toronto criticizing the smaller Opposition parties. He claimed these parties would always support the government because of their salaries.

The Speaker of the House of Commons ruled that the Leader

of the Opposition had gone too far in imputing motives and asked that the statements be withdrawn. In accordance with the Speaker's ruling, the Leader of the Opposition withdrew his statements and the House settled down to its routine business.

Four Measures

With reference to agriculture, there are four measures either on the order paper or that are expected to be placed there in the near future. These measures are:

- (1) Farm Credit Act—at present before the House of Commons as previously outlined.
- (2) Improvements to Farm Improvement Loans.
- (3) Introduction of legislation to deal with crop insurance. This will supplement provincial crop insurance plans.
- (4) An Act to assist in the very difficult problem of the high cost of farm machinery which is steadily and rapidly rising.

It is expected that these three latter matters will be proposed by the Minister of Agriculture in the near future.

I am pleased that the Rotary Club's Bonnie Place Senior Citizens' Home in Burlington will be officially opened on Saturday, June 20. This is a splendid example of municipal, provincial and federal co-operation in a much needed project initiated by the Rotary Club of Burlington.
