to Moorefield on Sunday evening to see a film about the work of Billy Graham and the World's Fair.

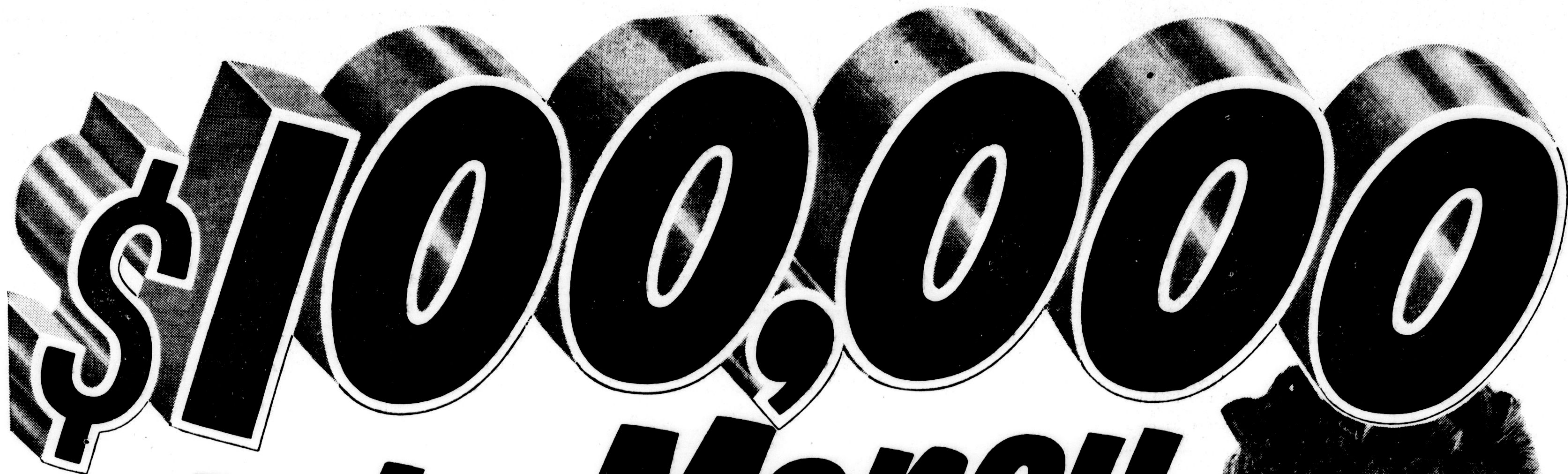
