Open German Language School Classes to Begin September 11

Over 30 Acton and Milton area residents interested in the German language — adults and children alike will be attending a special Saturday morning language school in Milton beginning on September 11.
 The German Canadian Club of Halton County, whose membership is mainly in the Milton-Acton area, has organized the area's first German language school and engaged Mr. Howard of Niagara Falls as the instructor.
 Classes are to be held, beginning September 11, in the W. I. Dick school, Milton with the sanction and support of the Federal Committee for German Language Schools.
Five Language
 Mr. Howard speaks and teaches five languages and the German Canadian Club executive members are pleased to be able to engage a man of his calibre to conduct the school. As there were not enough adult registrations for a separate class, adults and children will share the accommodation for lessons. Text books are to be supplied free to students through the Federal Committee, and costs of tuition have been set as low as possible to cover rentals and the teacher's salary.
