Ranger School

From the Department of Lands

and Forests bulletin comes the news that the Ranger School at beautiful Dorset, Ont., has started a class for conservation officers. This year, there are 137 young men and one woman taking the year long diploma course, specializing in forestry, fish and wildlife and allied subjects. This is no school for panty-waists.

They start at 7.30 each morning and most of the work in the daytime is field work outside in all kinds of weather. It is operated by the Ontario Government through the Dept. of Lands and Forests. Any young man or woman interested in this type of a career should apply to the Director, Ontario Forest Ranger School, Dorset, Ont. They will send you a bulletin on school requirements and other details.

As an example of the product this school turns out, this year a 90 mile trek through winter wilderness by the staff of the Department of Lands and Forests Division Base at the south end

of Lake Nipigon, far north of Lake Superior, brought Christmas to the kiddies of an Indian village of Auden. They took in candies and gifts for all the children on snowshoes, snowmobile as far as they could go, through 20 foot drifts and snow over a man's head. As we said before, this is no job for a panty-waist.

A report has finally come in from the pheasant hunt on Pelee Island last fall, when 1,453 hunters spent the open season, to bag 11,187 birds (8,243 cocks and 2,944 hens). The average hunter bagged 7.6 birds and 76 per cent of the hunters returned with their full quota of 10 birds.

If you haven't bought your cook book from one of the club members yet, here is an excellent recipe for cottontail rabbits. This is a tried recipe and makes excellent "rabbit cakes". First, skinkout your rabbit, cut into small pieces and soak in milk, salt and water overnight. In the morning, drain off the stale wa-

ter and parboil for about 15 minutes, after rinsing meat thoroughly in cold water. After parboiling, remove the meat from the bones, grind the meat fairly fine and mix with onion finely chopped, half cup mashed potatoes, fine bread crumbs. Mould into hamburger sized patties and fry in hot bacon fat. Man! Are they good!

Will Soon Announce Dates of TB Clinics

Dr. A. F. Bull, M.O.H. and Medical Advisor to the current Mass Tuberculin Testing and X-ray Survey in Halton County has issued a statement explaining the use of the tuberculin test and miniature films in the survey.

"Persons who receive a tuberculin test, are asked to return to the clinic on a specific day to determine if there has been a reaction to the test", Dr. Bull said. "All persons over 40 years of age, are then asked to have an X-ray. Diagnosis of tuberculosis is seldom made on the basis of the miniature film taken at the mobile X-ray units," he added.

Great Saving

"The small films used for mass X-raying of this kind represent a

great saving in time and money. Their purpose is to screen out cases that show suspicion of tuberculosis or some other abnormality", Dr. Bull explained.

"When a person's file is negative, that means that he is free of tuberculosis at that time. A notification to this effect will be sent to the individual. If the film reveals suspicious abnormalities, a larger X-ray must be taken for further study, to find out just what the trouble is. It does not mean that the persons necessarily have tuberculosis."

All persons whose films have such indications, are asked to attend a special clinic at an appointed time, in order for a larger film to be taken and further in-
