surmountable odds to prepare meals and snacks for the volunteers who searched the district for any trace of Marianne. The calamitous weekend, when about 18,000 flocked to the community to render assistance with the massive search was too much for them.

By Monday of last week, the searchers were reduced to over 200 men, mainly police from across Ontario and several Brampton factory workers who were laid off from their jobs. Feeding them was still a problem but the E.M.O. stepped in and, with the financial backing of Halton's emergency welfare fund, made sure there was enough food on hand to give the tired, weary searchers a decent meal.

Even with the financial help, the ladies were still required to prepare and serve the food. It was an all-day job to prepare a hot noon meal plus a mid-afternoon snack which the E.M.O. emergency feeding van delivered to the men in the outlying districts wherever the search was being concentrated. The women gave unflinchingly of their time, and their household chores were all but forgotten as they rallied to aid the efforts to find Marianne in the best way they knew how.

"We are giving them the best we can", one kitchen helper said as she dished up a heaping plate of roast beef, potatoes, peas and gravy for a tired policeman who stood in the line-up at noon Thursday. "There is nothing too good for them, the men are beat when they come in from walking all morning in the swamps and the bush." Today, the searching has ended although the police are still investigating hundreds of tips and clues. The community is just about back to normal. But Marianne is still missing and the memory of those grim 10 days will never be completely gone.

JUST PASSING BY Throughout her 70 years, she had taken things very calmly. Now, as she sat knitting by the drawing room window, she barely raised her eyes from her work as her 15-year-old granddaughter rushed into the room, exclaiming, "Oh Granny, Father's fallen off the roof!" "I know, my child," was the gentle reply. "I saw him pass the window."
