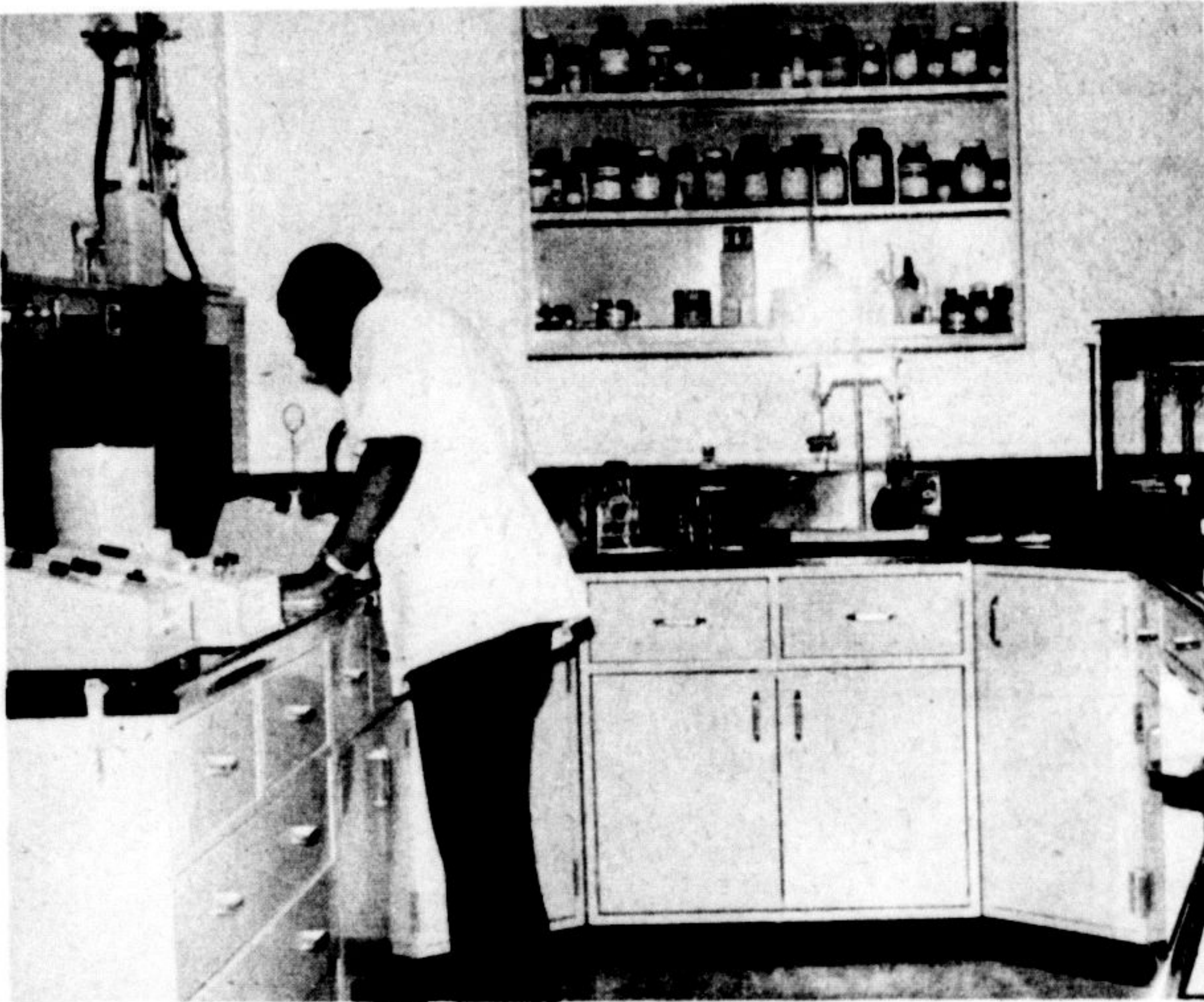
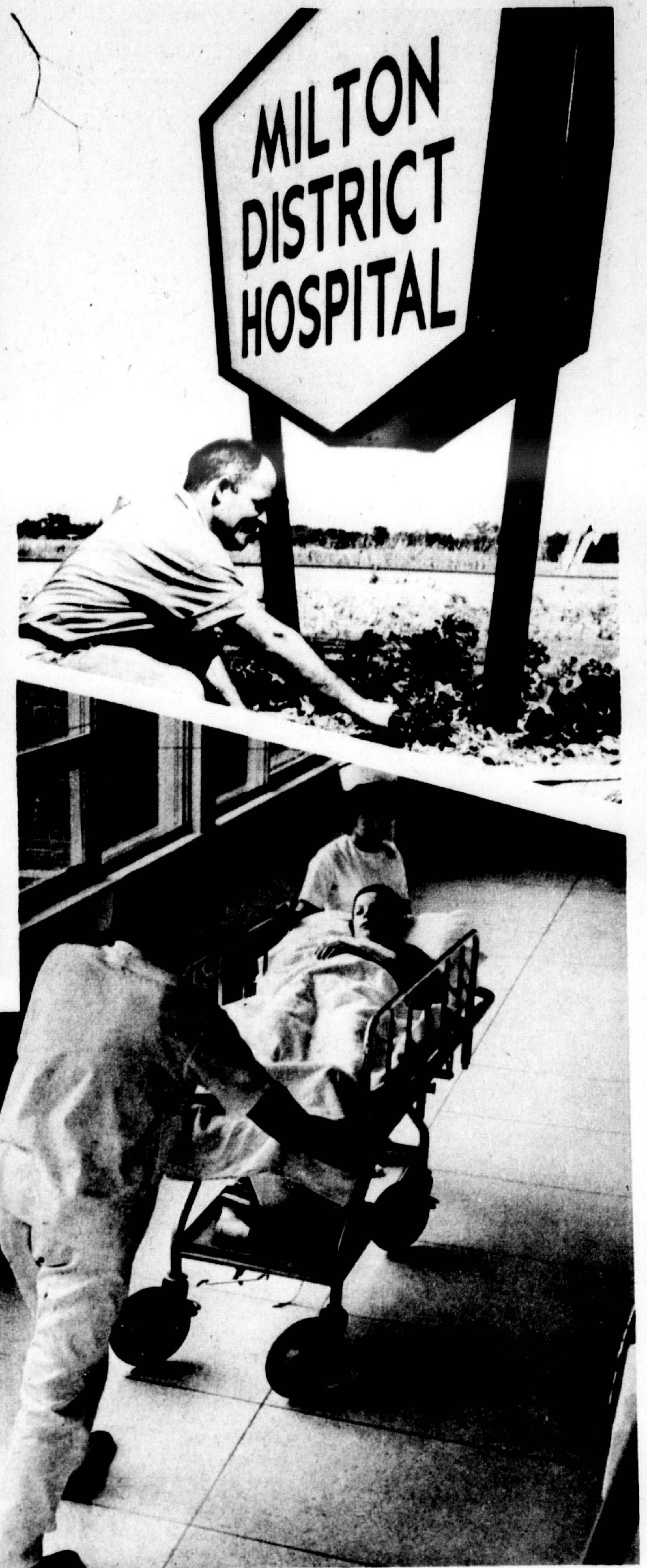
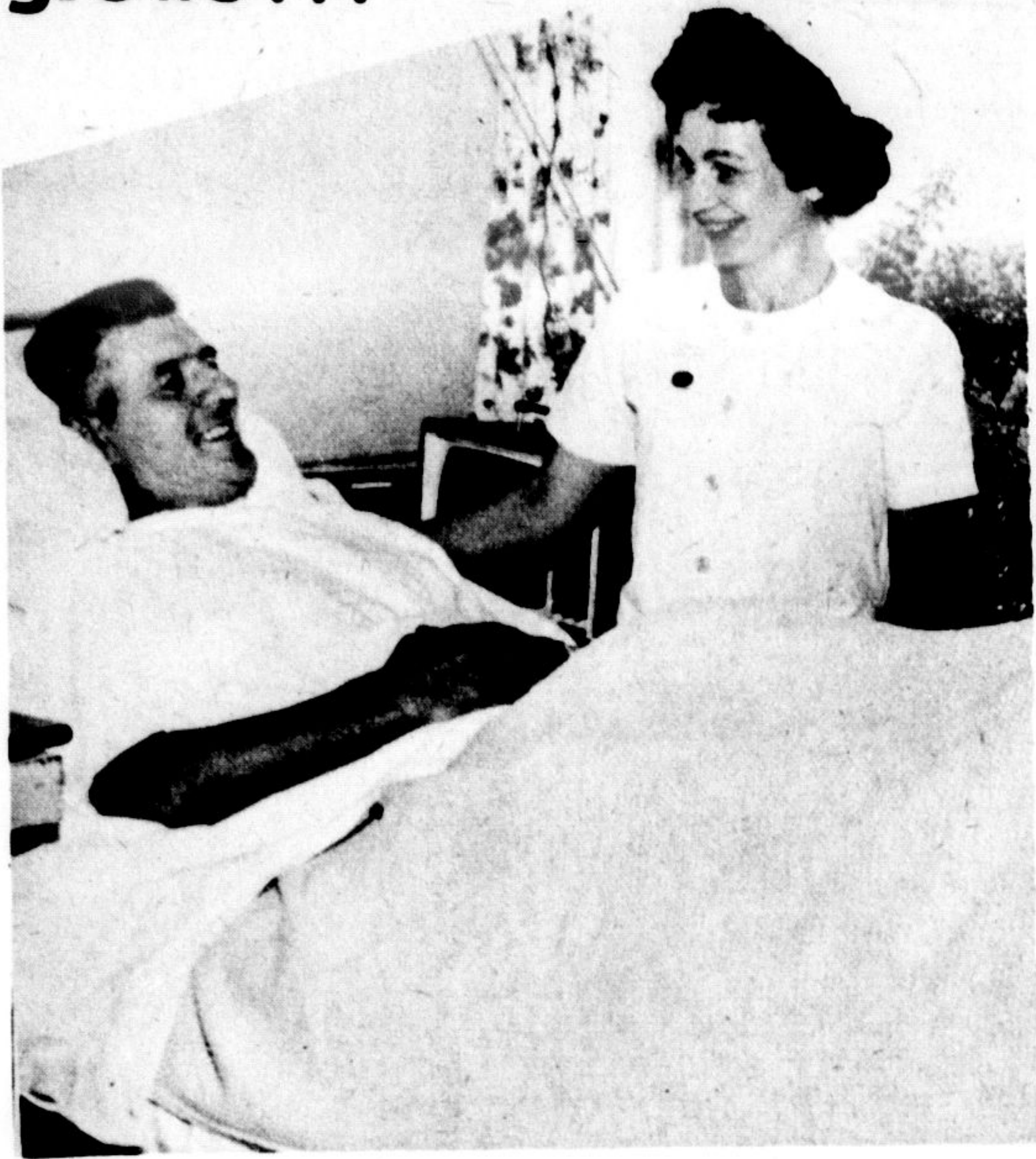


Your busy hospital grows and grows...



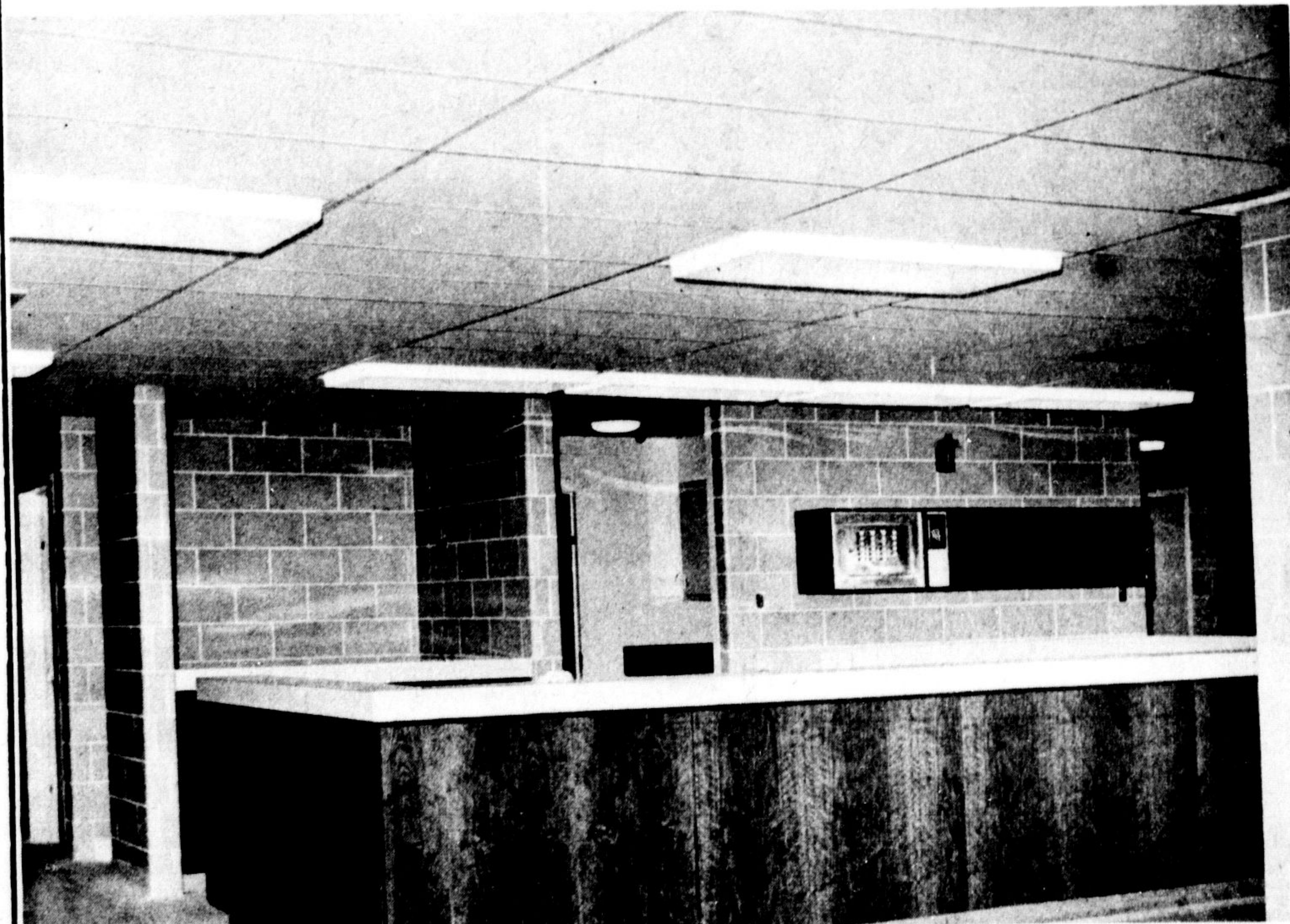
