O.P.P. investigate 4 P. D. accidents

For Period Sunday, May 21 to Saturday, May 27, 1967, inclusive.

During the period May 21, -27, inclusive, personnel of the Milton Detachment, Ontario Provincial Police, worked a total of 819 hours and patrolled a total of 7,886 miles on area highways.

As a result of patrol, 49 traffic charges were preferred; 77 Traffic Violation Warnings issued, and 212 vehicles were safety checked.

There was one Personal Injury Accident resulting in one person being injured; 4 Property Damage Accidents investigated and approximately \$2645. in Property Damage was recorded.

Causes of Accidents were -Illegal parking on the roadway; Inattentive driving and driving off roadway.

Two charges under the Highway Traffic Act were laid as a result of the above acci-

There were 49 general occurrences during this period, including one theft of auto which was recovered in Brampton; two persons charged with possession of Stolen Property; four L.C.A. investigations resulting in 14 persons being charged under the Liquor Control Act; one minor theft, and two premises found insecure at night. Other occurrences were of a minor nature.
