

The group had a good day for their trip and stayed through the day and watched the grandstand show and fireworks in the evening.


W. F. Harbottle arranged the trip, as he did the spring trip to Florida. Senior Citizens are planning a trip to California in October.

Support low-cost housing but where is low-cost land?

Pressed for an answer to a brief presented in February, Milton Council Monday indicated it supported the need for low-cost housing, but questioned how it could be done without low-cost land.

The Oakville District Labor Council brief, presented February 28, urged consideration of housing for senior citizens and for low income families.

"The principle is fine but the problem is economics," Councillor C. Johnson observed.

Mayor S. G. Childs noted the senior citizens' project had been assumed by the Rotary Club and he summed up the

council was agreed in principle to the need for housing for low income families.


